

## INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING

### AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Chapter 39.34 of the Revised Code of Washington and to other applicable laws, the Northshore School District and, the University of Washington, Seattle, Washington, hereby agree to cooperative governmental purchasing upon the following terms and conditions.


- (1) This Agreement pertains to bids and contracts for supplies, material, equipment or services that may be required from time to time by both the Northshore School District and the University of Washington.
- (2) Each of the parties from time to time goes out to public bid and contracts to purchase supplies, material, equipment, and services. Each of the parties hereby agrees to extend to the other party the right to purchase pursuant to such bids and contracts to the extent permitted by law, and to the extent agreed upon between each party and the bidder, contractor, vendor, supplier, or service provider.
- (3) Each of the parties shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations governing its own purchases.
- (4) Each of the parties shall contract directly with the bidder, contractor, vendor, supplier, or service provider, and pay directly in accordance with its own payment procedures for its own purchases. Each party will indemnify and hold the other party harmless as to any claim arising out of its participation in this Agreement.
- (5) Any purchase made pursuant to this Agreement is not a purchase from either of the parties. This Agreement shall create no obligation to either of the parties to purchase any particular good or service, nor create to either of the parties any assurance, warranty, or other obligation from the other party with respect to purchasing or supplying any good or service.
- (6) No separate legal or administrative entity is intended to be created pursuant to this Agreement. No obligation, except as stated herein, shall be created between the parties or between the parties and any applicable bidder or contractor.

(7) The ~~(insert applicable title)~~ <sup>Superintendent</sup> and Associated Director, Procurement Services of the University of Washington shall be representatives of the entities for carrying out the terms of this Agreement.

(8) This Agreement shall continue in force until canceled by either party, which cancellation may be effected upon receipt by one of the parties of the written notice of cancellation of the other party.



RESOLUTION NO. 638

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties, Washington, to participate in a Joint Purchasing Agreement with the University of Washington, Seattle, Washington, for purchase of school and office furniture;

WHEREAS, the State has authorized interlocal cooperation agreements between other governmental agencies or agents; and

WHEREAS, the University of Washington has awarded a contract to Bank and Office Interiors for the purchase of school and office furniture; and

WHEREAS, the contract allows for the extension of the terms and conditions of the contract to Northshore School District No. 417 and other school districts to the extent permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, Northshore School District No. 417 wishes to reduce the cost of purchasing furniture needed to support the operation of the school district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties Washington, and the University of Washington, Seattle, Washington, hereby agree as follows:

1. That an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement be formed between Northshore School District No. 417 and the University of Washington for the purpose of purchasing school and office furniture.
2. That the superintendent or designee of Northshore School District No. 417 is hereby authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.
3. That Northshore School District No. 417 reserves the right to contract independently for the purchase of any items or services, with or without notice to the University of Washington.
