# Successful Graduation 2020

- West Campus held a drive-thru graduation on June 13th at the West campus
- Okma Campus held a drive-in graduation on June 14th at Bloomfield Hills High School
- East Campus held a drive-thru graduation on June 15th at the East Campus and a more formal drive-thru on June 20th at the Troy Civic Center complex

# Spring Break 2021 Proposal

- Move spring break to March 29- April 2th. School will resume Monday, April 5th
- Early Release for PD on August 28th, full day of instruction on May 5th
  - this change provides us with more opportunity to hold PD in the beginning of the year given the unknowns of our current school situation

# Spring Break 2022 Proposal

- Spring Break will be moved to March 28- April 1st
- School Resumes April 4th

# IB Exams 2020

- All internal assessments for each course were submitted for grading (instead of a sample)
- Students can re-test in November 2020 if they choose
- Colleges and universities who responded to the IB's survey indicated that 98% of admissions decisions will not be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. 85% indicated their standard policy for awarding credit or placement would hold for the Class of 2020.

# IB Exams 2021

- IB has a response team evaluating course requirements in response to COVID-19
- Will continue to operate under the principles of fairness and compassion to minimize the negative impact on students

# Planning for 2020-21 School Year

- 32 teachers/counselors/administrators from across our three campuses met to start planning for online learning next school year
- Based on the feedback from students, parents/guardians and staff we discussed the following:
  - Increased consistency in courses
  - Increased live instruction
  - Concerns around the Social Emotional wellbeing of students
  - Live Instruction
  - Expectations for attendance, homework, norms

# Planning for 2020-21 School Year

- We held two days of PD on June 15-16th that focused on planning within departments for the first few weeks of school
- Included in the PD was a review of where we are in terms of staff training and how to best leverage our learnings on the first day of school
- Approximately 30 staff members are currently engaged in a book study on *White Fragility*
- Free summer “Anti-Racist Book Club enrichment hosted by two staff members



# Tri-Campus Anti-Racism Committee

- After each campus held a forum to discuss issues around race in America on June 9-11th, we created a tri-campus anti-racist student committee
- Mrs. Juco and I met with these students as a tri-campus group
- This week, each campus scheduled a student/staff meeting to discuss hopes and ideas for an anti-racist school community. Several staff members volunteered to participate
- Many ideas have been generated and we are working on a staff/student community message that includes ideas for action over the summer
