This program provides talented seventh graders in the Germantown community with a strong Pre-Algebra foundation. We believe that this program will aid in their readiness for an Algebra 1 course, success on standardized state tests, and the application process necessary for enrollment in competitive high schools. Breakthrough of Greater Philadelphia

Celebrating 25 years in academic excellence, this three-year academic enrichment program for rising seventh-grade students aims to increase a student's opportunity to attend and succeed at competitive high schools in the greater Philadelphia area, and ultimately to envision themselves at 4-year colleges. This amazing year-round opportunity is free!

Community Basketball and Enrichment Camp

This four-week summer program serves rising third through ninth graders by combining basketball training and classroom instruction, building on the relationships formed between coach and camper. Basketball takes place in the GFS gyms and focuses on skill-building, teamwork, and sportsmanship. In collaboration with the Friends Free Library on the GFS campus, students enrolled in this program reinforce the fundamentals of reading, writing, and math. There is a nominal fee for this program, but financial assistance is available.
