



Statement on CRRSAA Emergency Grant Funds – March 1, 2021

In accordance with the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) II Program, Fisher College has received notification from the U.S. Department of Education of the awarding of student grant funding under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA).

Under Section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA, institutions of higher education are directed to provide emergency grants to students with exceptional need. The grants may be used by students for any component of their cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care. The total amount of funds that have been allocated to Fisher College for its students under the CRRSAA is \$248,345.

Per distribution guidance, 321 Fisher College students have been determined to be eligible to receive funding. Each eligible student will receive an equitable distribution in the amount of \$774 each. Please note that as of the date of this posting (March 1, 2021), the funds have not yet been distributed.
