is an online stock brokerage app named Robinhood which allows traders to trade stock commission-free. Robinhood sparked controversy after it banned the trading of GameStop stock on its app. The CEO had to testify before Congress on February 18th because of the number of investors that traded GameStop shares through the platform which caused Melvin Capital to crash.

After this, I think we have learned a valuable lesson. In the age of social media where word of mouth epidemics can spread faster than ever before, we have to make sure that these messages are not dangerous. If we let social media go without being regulated our lives will operate based on viral messages. Now we understand more than ever just how powerful social media can be and how a small number of everyday people can cause a \$13 billion hedge fund to drop 53% all with a few clicks.



> President Joe Biden announced the purchase of 200 million more vaccines for the US. This brings the total vaccine doses to 300 million, nearly enough to vaccinate the entire population of 328 million Americans. According to the President's plan, the entire country could be vaccinated by the end of the summer. The President has also committed to increasing the weekly vaccine supply to the states to a minimum of 10 million

One of the major challenges with vaccinating the citizens has been the distribution within the states and the COVID vaccination centers. According to the CDC, more than 48 million vaccine doses have been distributed to the states but only 26 million vaccines have been administered.
