

STUDENT HEALTH

The superintendent shall arrange for health services for all students. Such services will include but are not be limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records;
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- C. Consulting services of a licensed healthcare provider and/or Registered Nurse;
- D. Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening;
- E. Immunization records and screening.
