**Contract for Educational Services
Between
Northshore School District

Seattle Public Schools**

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34 of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides for interlocal cooperation between governmental agencies, and
WHEREAS, each school in the State of Washington is required by RCW 28A.155.010 to ensure that all children with disabilities shall have the opportunity for an appropriate education at public expense, and
WHEREAS, each school district is authorized by RCW 28A.155.020 to participate in an Agreement to secure such appropriate educational opportunity for children with disabilities, and
WHEREAS, each resident district has within its boundaries resident children with disabilities as described in Chapter 392-172A WAC, and
WHEREAS, each resident district has determined that certain such children can most appropriately be served through an Agreement pursuant to RCW 39.34, RCW 28A.155.090 and RCW 28A.225.250.
THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

I. Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to provide educational services at Seattle Public Schools (SPS) beginning September 4, 2020 and continuing through July 31, 2021 for [REDACTED] a resident student of Northshore School District, who qualifies for special education programs pursuant to Chapter 392 – 172A WAC.

II. Responsibilities of Seattle Public Schools (SPS)

1. The SPS will provide education services as outlined in the Individualized Education Program (IEP).
2. The education services will be provided remotely through the BRIDGES program located at Roxhill Annex, 9430 30th Ave SW, Seattle, WA 98126. If in person learning resumes, services will be provided at an SPS location.
3. The student will be supervised by the staff of BRIDGES.
4. SPS will provide opportunity for the Northshore School District Director of Special Education or the Director's designee to observe, confer with staff, and otherwise monitor the program for the above-named student as provided by chapter 392-172A. WAC.
5. Transportation services will be provided by the Northshore School District that follow the Seattle Public Schools calendar and district closures due to inclement weather.

III. Responsibilities of the Northshore School District (NSD)

1. Prior to entering this Inter District Agreement, the NSD will perform an appropriate review of the case information and develop objectives based upon assessment of the

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student. This will include, as requested by SPS, development of an addendum to the IEP.

2. This Addendum will include, but is not limited to, development of a contingency plan for the management of behavior associated with serious threat to self, others, or property.
3. The Seattle Public Schools Student Support Services Supervisor or Supervisor's designee will observe, confer with staff, and otherwise monitor the program for the above-named student.

IV. Terms of the Inter District Agreement

1. Charges and reimbursement under this Inter District Agreement will be as follows and will be paid by the NSD based on an invoice submitted by SPS in the amount of \$565.96 per day for program services.
2. While it is contemplated that the total financial obligation of the NSD shall be no more than \$101,824.00 for the duration of this Inter District Agreement, based on the per diem amount and number of school calendar days, any additional expenses incurred by SPS solely for delivery of special education and/or related services to the student shall be an additional charge to NSD and shall be invoiced and paid in the same manner as the per diem charges.
3. This Inter District Agreement may be changed, consistent with the contract, law, or service needed at any time by mutual written Inter District Agreement of the NSD and the SPS.
4. This Inter District Agreement may be terminated, as outlined, by either party.
5. All conditions of this Inter District Agreement and services delivered under this Inter District Agreement are governed by the agreement, and the student's IEP.
6. For this Inter District Agreement to be valid, SPS must be approved by the Washington State Board of Education, on or before and have continuous approval during this Inter District Agreement to serve students with disabilities.

This Inter District Agreement is effective on the 4th day of September 2020 and terminates on the 31st day of July 2021.
