

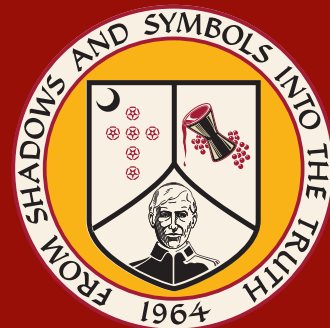

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS CLASS OF 2021

**COURSE WORK**  
One semester of coursework equals 5 credits, 10 credits equaling one year of coursework. Taking seven courses each semester for four years and completing community service allows the student to complete 290 credits. The 270 credits listed under graduation requirements are the minimum to graduate. Additional coursework in Modern and Classical Languages, Mathematics and Science is recommended by the UC and California State University systems.
