## **Medication Administration Policy**

If your child needs to take medication throughout the school day a *Request for Medication Administration* form must be completed and turned into the nurse. For all <u>Over-the-Counter and Prescription</u> medications you must include the following:

- Name of child
- Reason for medication
- O Name of medication to be administered
- o <u>Dosage for medication</u>
- Prescribed quantity for each medication
- Time of administration
- Frequency of administration
- Route of administration

All medication must be brought to school <u>by the parent</u> in the original labeled container prepared by the pharmacy, doctor, or pharmaceutical company (i.e., no envelopes, foil, or baggies). The label should include the following:

- Child's name
- Name of medication
- Dosage of medication to be given
- Frequency of administration
- Route of administration
- Date of prescription
- Expiration date

NOTE: Specific instructions are necessary (for example, every 4 hours, as needed for headache).

If your child self carries medication such as an Epi-pen or Inhaler they will need to have a self carry order signed by parents/guardians and a physician. The student will need to have a copy of this form with them at all times as well, the nurse must have a copy. Students must meet with the nurse at the beginning of the school year to show compliance, please email Nurse Dellinger to set up an appointment. This can be done during a study hall, before or after school, or during lunch. Appointments must be established before <a href="September 2">September 2</a>, 2022. Please make sure your student is setting up an appointment. If you are unable to access these forms please email the nurse at dellingerm@chsvb.org

If your child has <u>Asthma, Allergies, Seizures, or Diabetes</u> they must complete an action plan regarding these illnesses. The student will need to have a copy of this plan with them at all times. The nurse must have a copy as well. These action plans can be found on the Magnus portal as well as the Health/Clinic page of the CHS website. If you are unable to access these forms please email the nurse at dellingerm@chsvb.org.

All <u>Action/Medication/Self-Carry</u> forms must be completed and uploaded to the students <u>Magnus portal</u> by the first day of school.
