Selecting Classes for Senior Year

In February, the college counselors met with the juniors during their Theology class to begin the process of selecting classes for senior year. Mr. Rodewald and Mr. O'Brien have been meeting with the juniors to discuss their options and to make sure that each student will meet the graduation requirements. After the counselors meet with the juniors, class choices will be entered in PowerSchool.

ACT / SAT Information

As has been mentioned in previous newsletters, almost 1,500 colleges and universities will be test optional for the Class of 2023. Even though many schools are test optional, it is our recommendation that students take the ACT or SAT once during junior year. In the fall, if a student decides to apply to a college or university that requires a test score for admission, they will not have to scramble to take either test. In addition, some colleges and universities may require a test score in order to be considered for their top scholarships. Also some private organizations may require test scores when awarding their scholarships.

Because a student chooses when to take either the ACT or SAT, counselors DO NOT register the student. The students choose what date they will take the test. Test dates for the remainder of junior year and first semester of senior year and the websites for the ACT and SAT are listed here.
