Krak!*, a National Book Award finalist; *The Farming of Bones*, an American Book Award winner; *The Dew Breaker*, a PEN/Faulkner Award finalist and winner of the inaugural Story Prize; and *Everything Inside*, a Reese's Book Club pick and winner of the Story Prize. The recipient of a MacArthur Fellowship, she has been published in *The New Yorker*, *The New York Times*, and elsewhere. Ms. Danticat lives in Miami.
