### Signing In & Out

Students who are enrolled in Community School and/or Intramural Sports will be dismissed directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the class begins. The instructor will pick up your child from Kid Power and escort them to their designated area for their afterschool class. Once the class is over, please meet your child at the lower school front lobby doors for pick up. Any student who does not get picked up after their class has been over for 10 minutes, will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily after care rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's account.

### **Payment**

- Pay with your debit or credit card directly through your LMP tuition account. Transaction fee will apply.
- Pay by check: Please place your check or money order in your child's school folder or drop it off at the front desk. Please notify the teacher that you have a payment in the folder that needs to be turned in for extra-curricular activities.
- Extracurricular program payments are due one week prior to the start of the program.
   Parents are responsible for the entire amount of each program. If LMP can not physically open its doors due to acts of God or health & safety reasons, parents will not be responsible for the unattended week. However, if you choose to have your child miss a class or if your child is absent, you are still responsible for the fees.
