21st Century Scholars



Herron Classical Schools has signed on as a partner with the Indiana Latino Institute in their effort to update the laws surrounding the 21st Century Scholars Program. Currently, the program offers fulltuition scholarships for lower-income students who sign up with the program in 8th grade. If they can maintain a solid GPA and complete college-centered tasks during high school, they will receive this scholarship, valid at any Indiana college. While the program does allow for many low income students, especially students of color, to attend college with little to no debt, there have been many instances of students and families falling through the cracks in recent years.

The proposed changes will allow for automatic enrollment for all free/reduced lunch 7th and 8th graders across the state, give high schools the ability to further enroll students into their 9th grade year, and increase funding for the Padres Estrellas program, which promotes family engagement and understanding of the 21st Century Scholars process.
