For the first semester of senior year, the primary source for scholarships will be to submit applications by the college or university's deadline. The importance of knowing and meeting the deadline was stressed to the seniors when the college counselors met with them in the first week of school.

Most outside / private scholarships will have deadlines in second semester. Three websites that may be used to complete an online scholarships search for the scholarships are: Fastweb Sallie Mae College Covered. In addition to having a scholarship search, all three websites have lots of additional information, covering topics such as college planning, financial aid, student loans, and student life in college. Information about area scholarships will be published in Marian's daily bulletin or emailed directly to the seniors.
