



Dear Seniors and Parents,

The Senior Lock-in is quickly approaching on October 6th and we need your help with food and decoration donations. Student Council will provide pizza, but we are asking for the following food donations:

**Last Name A - F:** Side dishes (salads, pasta, rice, fruit, rolls, etc.)

**Last Name G - L:** Snacks (chips, dip, salsa, veggies, pretzels, granola bars, etc)

**Last Name M - R:** Individual Drinks (water, cans of pop, juice boxes, etc)

**Last Name S - Z:** Desserts (cookies, brownies, cupcakes, etc.)

It would be very helpful if everyone would bring in donations according to their last name classification. This will help us to ensure that we have enough food for everyone. Food donations can be brought to Room 234 during the school day on October 6th, or they can be brought to the cafeteria when you arrive for the lock-in. (If it needs to be refrigerated please bring it with you when you come to the lock-in).

Lastly, we want to remind you that all of the decorations that you see on Mum Day are supplied by the seniors themselves. If we want to go all out, we need an ample supply of decorations. Donations of crêpe paper and streamers, and high quality masking tape and painters tape are needed. Supplies (along with other helpful items except food) can be brought to Room 234, preferably by Monday 10/3/22.

Once the lock-in begins, we cannot go out and buy more supplies, so we need to be well prepared!
