

7075 AWARDING CONTRACTS

In all construction and repairs by contract or otherwise, preference shall be given to Duluth material and labor when all other things are equal and when locally manufactured material of approved quality can be procured. All specifications shall contain a clause to this effect. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the School Board from specifically directing the manner in which any particular purchase shall be made or contract entered into, or improvement undertaken, when either the exigency of a case or the advantage of the School District makes it desirable to depart from the usual method. Contracted forms shall be prepared by the Superintendent and his/her staff and be approved by the School Board. Such forms shall be designed in accordance with State law as to format, terminology, and methods of execution.

Before executing any contract, the School Board may require a proper bond for the faithful performance of any work and payment for all labor and material used in performance.
