

## Physics/Chemistry Faculty Position

The Maine School of Science & Mathematics invites applications for an Instructor of Physics and Chemistry, with a starting date of August, 2023. Candidates should have at least three years of university and/or high school teaching experience and be comfortable teaching algebra-based Physics, calculus-based Physics (AP Physics C), Chemistry, and can offer upper-level electives in the physical sciences. In recent years electives have included Geology, Meteorology, Solar Technology, and Quantum Mechanics.

A minimum of a Masters in Physics, or related discipline is required, with a PhD preferred. Teaching load will be three sections of at most 16 students with weekly labs (up to three preps per semester). The ideal candidate should be well versed in student centered teaching methods, and have an interest in mentoring/advising student activities. Previous experience in lab safety coordination and chemical hygiene is a plus.
