Although we as students may not have liked the changes to

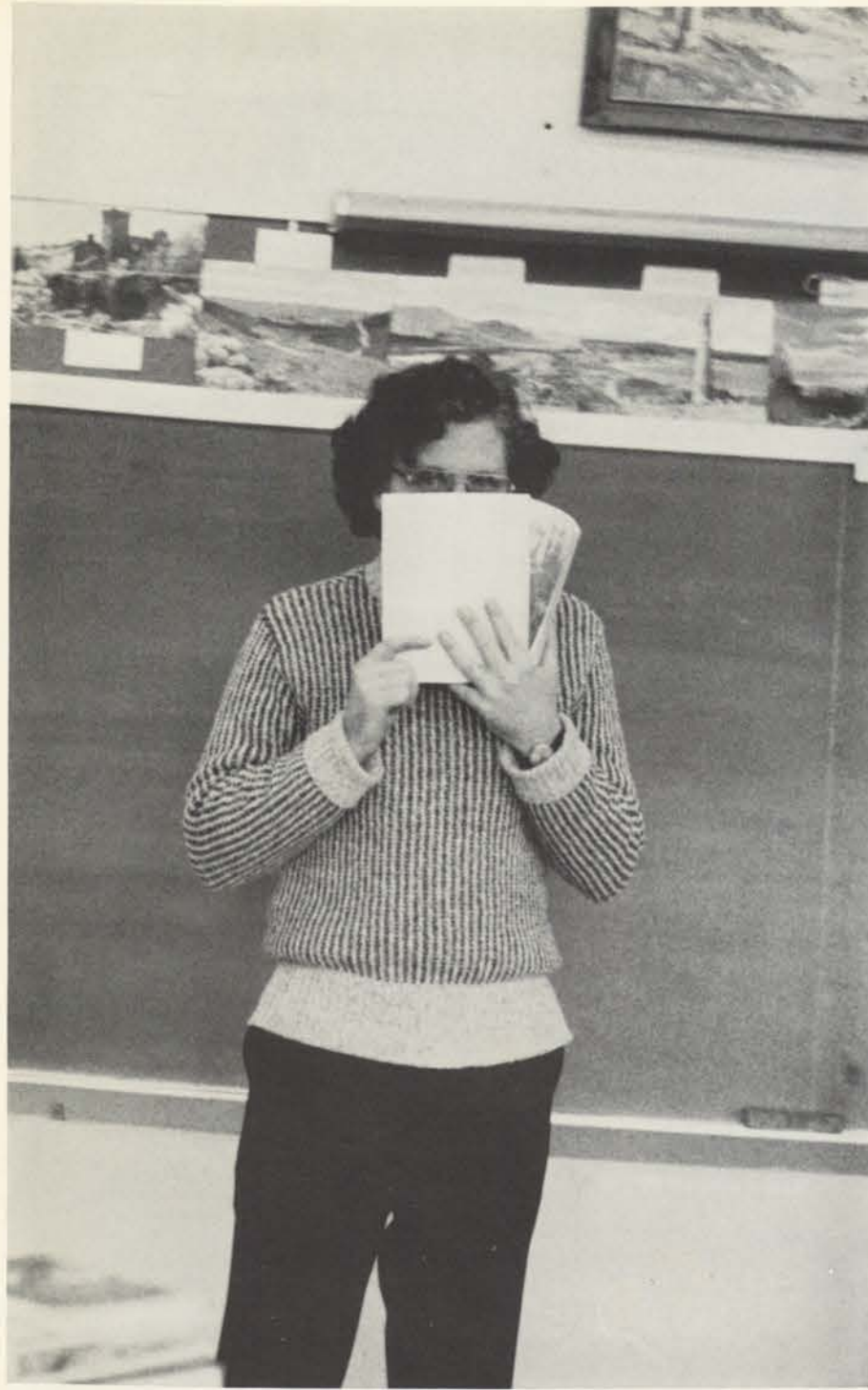
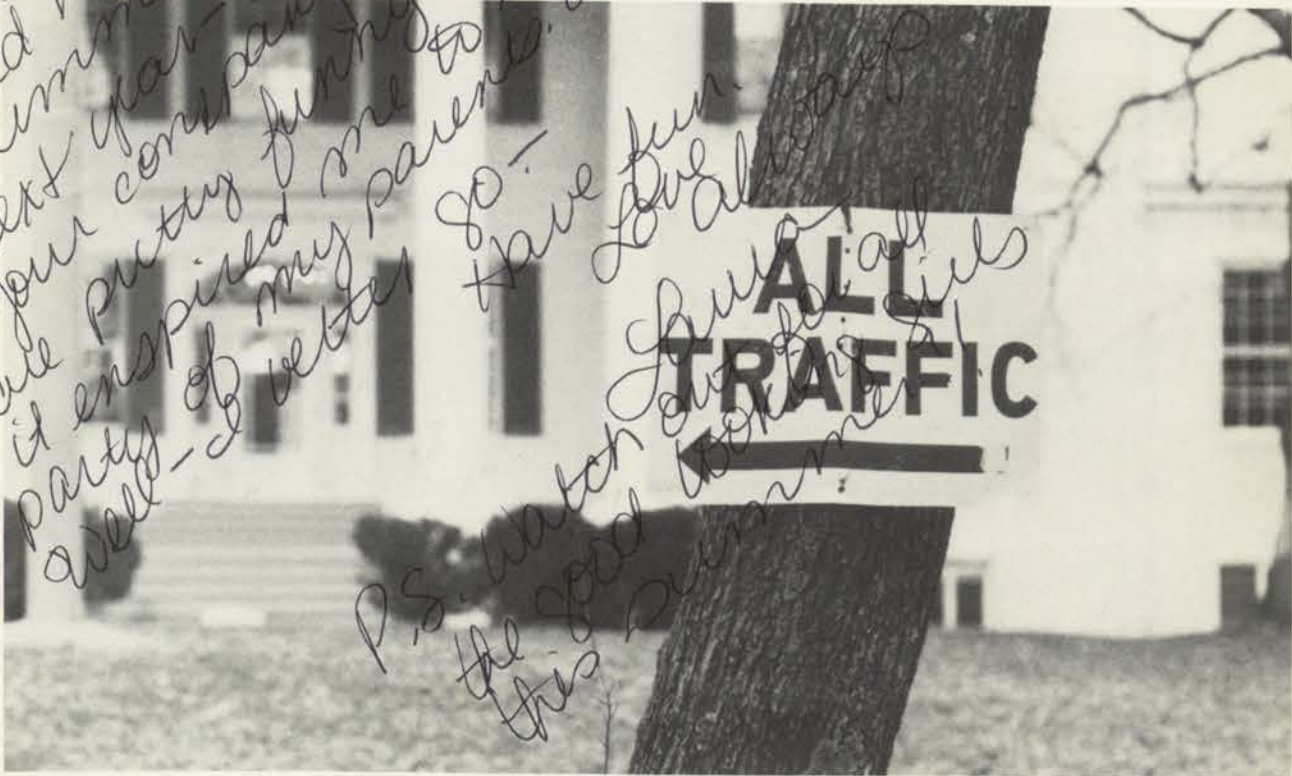
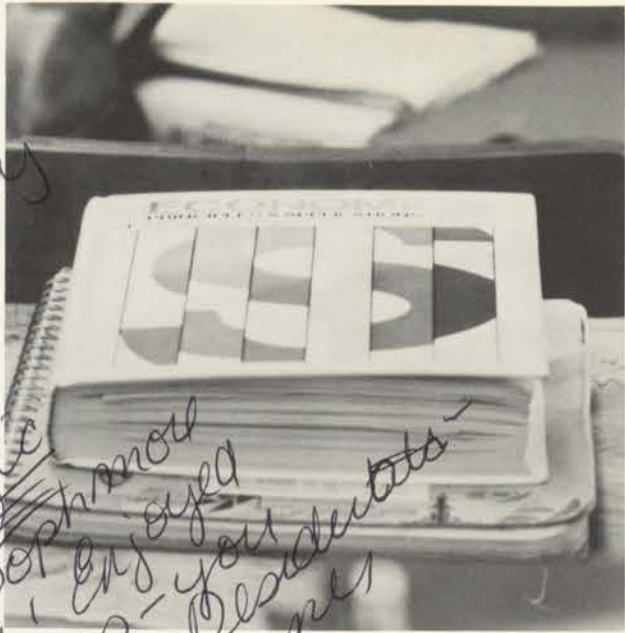


a 9 period day, after school sports, not as many study halls, and other unpopular changes we feel that the changes made over the years have been excellent ones.
