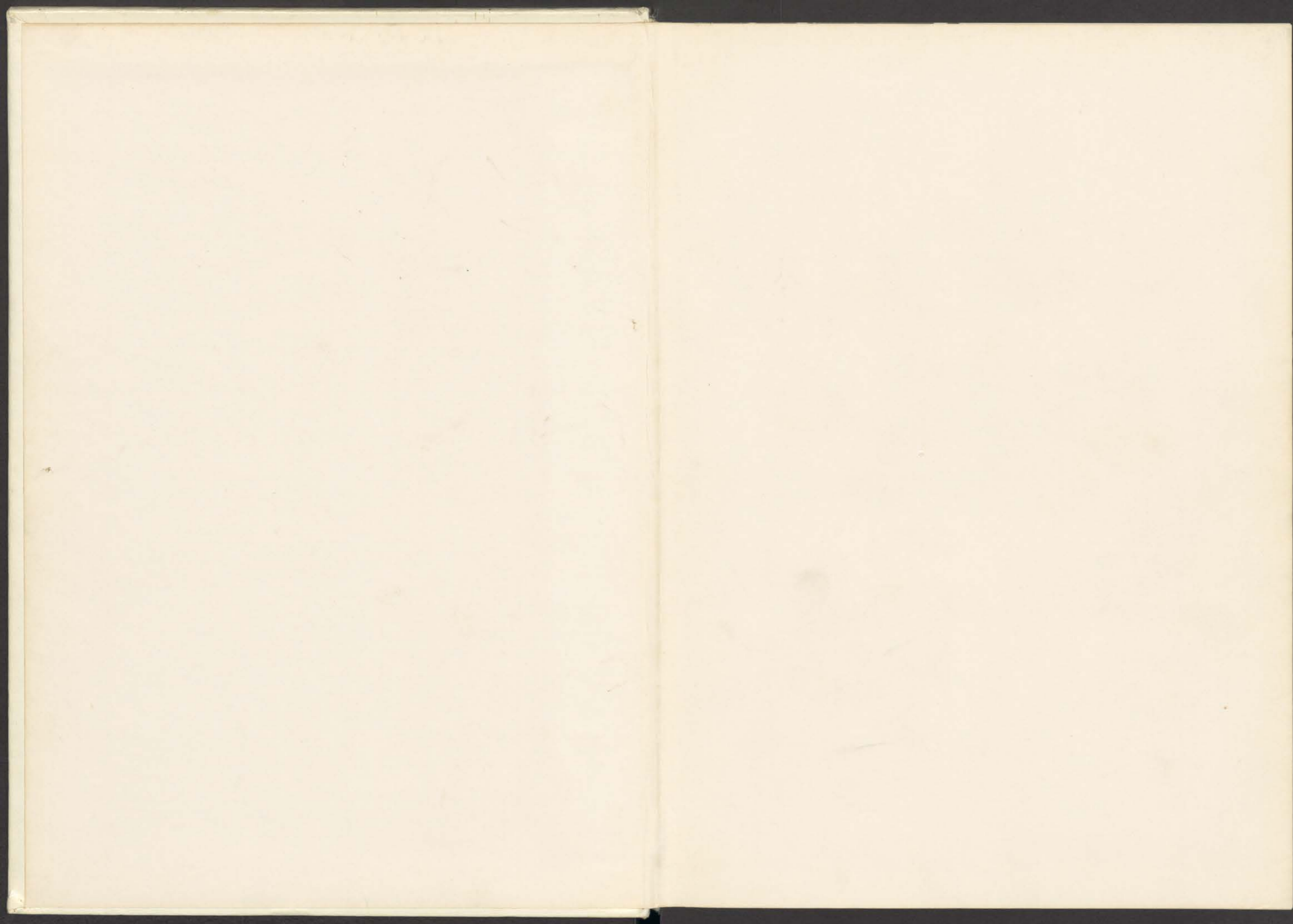

## WE'RE WATCHING YOU



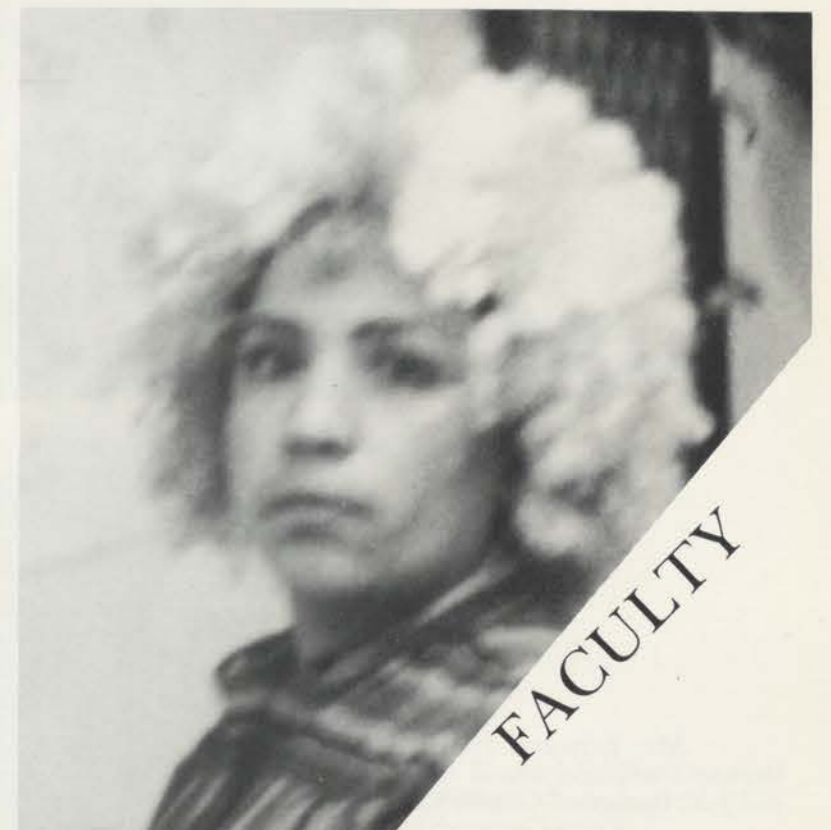
I am very proud of the members of our faculty and staff this school year. These are men and women who are deeply committed to education and wish to teach in a Christian school because they believe in our cause.
