

2024-2025 DRESS CODE

Buffalo Seminary does not require a uniform. The SEM dress code exists to allow students to express their individual style while also acknowledging SEM as an academic institution.

It is the responsibility of each student and their guardian to check attire before leaving for school. Together, we strive to dress in a manner that supports our expectations of the SEM community.

Student attire will be checked each morning by individual advisors and throughout the day by teachers and administrators. If a student is out of dress code, they will receive a pink slip and must change immediately. We require all students to have a change of clothes in their locker at all times. SEM will not be responsible for providing extra clothing for students who are out of dress code. Please refer to the list of permitted clothing which fall within SEM's dress code:

- Shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts, and sweaters without logos, words, graphics & pictures
- SEM t-shirts, long sleeves, and sweatshirts
- Pants, jeans, and non-athletic shorts free of rips and tears
- Dresses, skirts and shorts fingertip length
- Leggings worn with a top which meets the student's thigh
- Cultural headwraps, religious head coverings
- Sneakers, dress shoes, and boots
- Sandals in September, October, May and June only
- Coats with permission of classroom teacher
