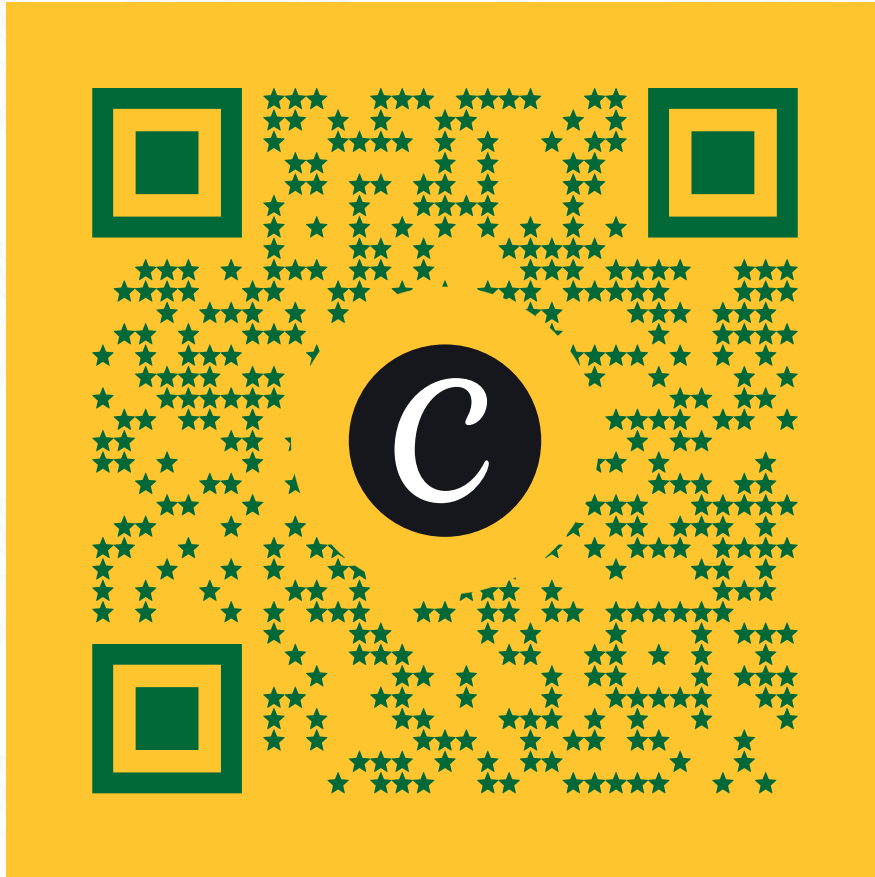

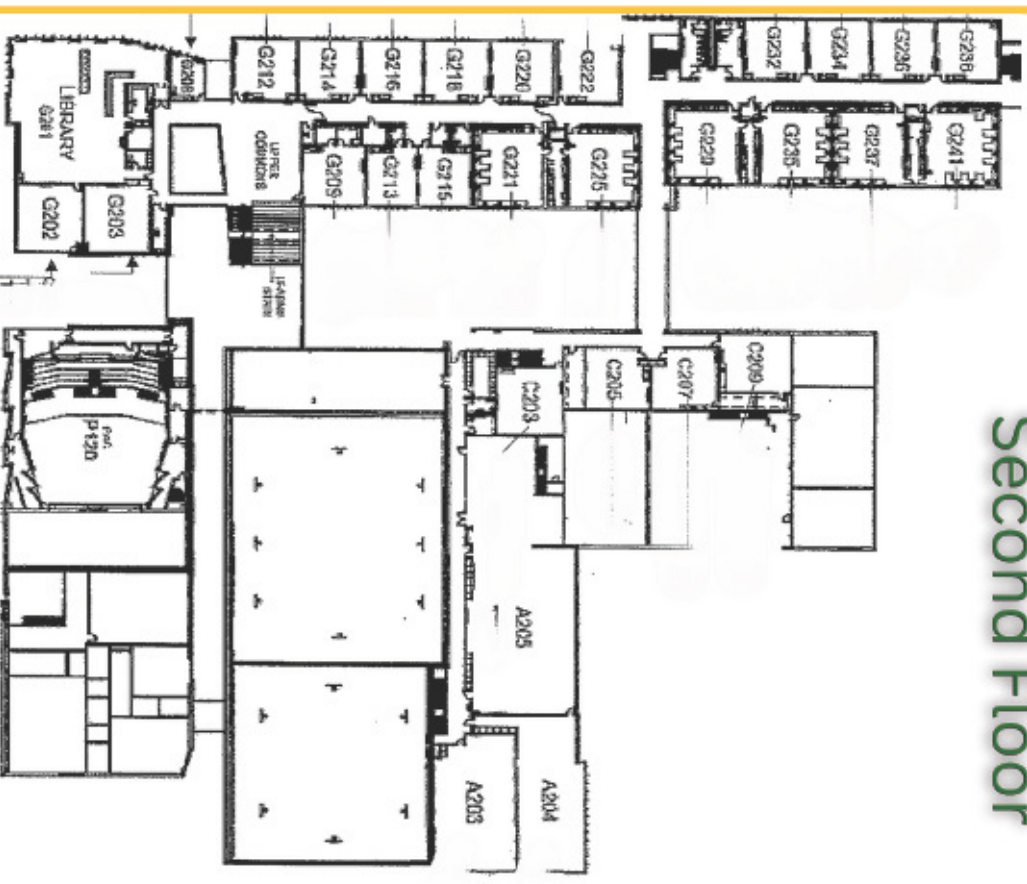

Interested in Joining a Sport?

1. Parents complete registration FIRST, then student completes their own registration next.
2. Parents must create an account, add their student and then upload information on Final Forms.
3. If the student is a first time user, they will need to login to their email and confirm their account before proceeding.
4. If you already have a FinalForms account, both the parent/guardian and the student must log in, update any necessary information, and sign all required forms.
5. Sports physicals are valid for two years. Be sure to schedule an appointment with your healthcare provider before your physical expires. Students with an expired physical will not be cleared to participate in practice.
6. An ASB card is required to participate in sports. Check with Mrs. Gates at the ASB window to see if you qualify for free or reduced-price meals. If you qualify, your ASB fee may be waived.

Stay Connected with ParentSquare

ParentSquare is Quincy School District's primary communication platform for families. Parents and guardians can use ParentSquare to receive important school and district updates, messages, announcements, and event information.

Please make sure your ParentSquare account is activated and your contact information is up to date so you don't miss important communications throughout the school year.

Families have ParentSquare, students have StudentSquare!

StudentSquare is an app for teachers and school staff to communicate directly with students, and students communicate to their teachers, counselors and other staff.

Each high school student automatically has a StudentSquare account using their district student email address. Students receive messages via email, but there are other ways to get StudentSquare messages: students can add their cell number to receive text messages, or they can download the StudentSquare app (iOS and Android) and receive notifications.

Why Should Students Download StudentSquare?

- Be one of the first to know about weather delays and closures
- Message your teachers with questions about assignments
- Get important information about school from principals
- Receive emergency notifications about lockdowns

StudentSquare is only available to high school students and cannot be used to message other students. StudentSquare is not a social media platform, but rather a communication platform used for schools to pass along useful and timely information to students.

Students can activate their StudentSquare account by clicking the invitation link sent to their school email or by downloading the StudentSquare app and following the prompts.

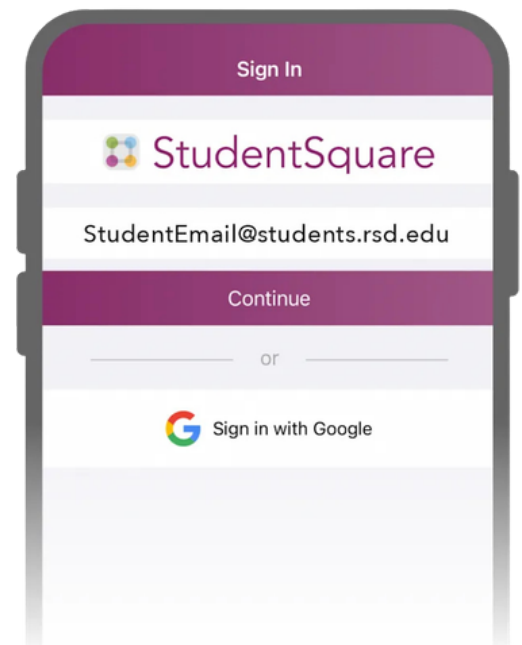
