- 60+ attendees including district administration, teachers, students, city officials and Canfield community residents.
- Session focused on examining current facilities, developing a vision for the district and brainstorming master plans that address the aging facilities in the district.
- Activities centered around establishing "Guiding Principles" to inform the master planning process; brainstorming ways that the district and facility committee could most effectively reach the Canfield community during the planning process; and developing preferred master plan options for Canfield Local Schools.

- **Be Fiscally Responsible** – to attract and retain families and be sustainable
