2024-2025 Portfolio Rubric Scoring Instructions and Guidance

Portfolio Rubric Scoring Instructions:

- Download and save the blank electronic essay scoring rubric to your computer before beginning the scoring process. You will re-use this scoring form for each applicant.
- Open a blank electronic scoring rubric and type the nominee's name in the box at the top left of the page.
- Open the electronic portfolio and read the information for the applicant.
- Refer back to the portfolio as many times as necessary to determine your score for each section. You are allowed to take notes during this process.
- Use the rubric statements and corresponding values to determine a score for each **section** and **column**. **Please note that many rubric competencies will receive a score for school and a score for church/community.**
- Place your section scores in the corresponding field text area provided at the bottom of each page
- Add the scores of each section to calculate your final score for the essay. Place this score at the top of page 1 and the bottom of page 2 for grades 5 and 8. Add to page 3 for grade 12.
- Once the form is complete, save the file as
 - **Portfolio_Region #_Grade Level Number_First initial of student_Last name of student_Your last name**
 - Example: **Portfolio_Region 1_Grade 8_J_Jones_Smith**
- Repeat these steps for each of the applicants.

Once you have finished scoring the portfolio, please email the scored files to the coordinator. If you took notes or printed the summary documents during your review, please destroy these, as they are considered confidential information. If you have any questions or are unable to serve in this capacity for any reason, please contact the coordinator.

Activities/Services/Citizenship Scoring Guidance:

- **School** refers to activities, services, leadership roles or honors/awards that impact the school or school system or awarded by the school or school system.
- **Church/community** refers to activities, services or leadership roles that impact a district, parish, state or national organization or activity
- A **wide variety** indicates more than half of the activities/ services/ citizenship are performed by the student (extra-curricular, service organizations, school organizations, church activities, volunteer work)
- A **variety** indicates a cross-section of participation in school organizations, extra-curricular activities, team participation or community organizations.
- **Many** refers to a great deal of participation in many of one type of activity (i.e. all sports, all school clubs)
- **Some** refers to participation in a few organizations, but not a cross-section of the activities referenced in this section.
- **Minimal** refers to very little active participation in service to school or community.
