Recommendation: Approval of new policy #5317, previously presented for board consideration and discussion at the Board of Education Meeting on March 23, 2026.

Background: The Board of Education and the District adhere to a regular policy review process to ensure: timely and appropriate updates to existing policies; the implementation of new policies as warranted; the elimination of outdated / conflicting policies; and grammatical / language revisions as needed.

#5317 - Enrollment of Expelled Students (*Students*) - Policy outlining that a majority vote of the Board (as required by state statute) would be required to enroll any student during the term of any known expulsion of the student from any public or private school in any state.

The District shall not enroll any student during the term of any known expulsion of the student from any public school in any state unless the Board has approved the enrollment by a vote of a majority of the members of the Board. The District shall not enroll any student during the known term of any expulsion of the student from a private school in any state for an offense for which expulsion is authorized for a public school student unless the Board has approved the enrollment by a vote of a majority of the members of the Board. This Policy does not require the Board to take a vote on the enrollment application of any such student.
