**Recommendation:** None at this time. Presenting proposed changes to Policy 6340 - Student Fees for the 2026-2027 school year. These changes will be presented for approval on May 11, 2026.

**Purpose:** The presentation of proposed changes to student fees at the Public Hearing provides the opportunity for the board and the public to comment on the proposed changes. For the 2026-2027 school year, those changes include: increase in lunch prices (K-12); clarifying language to the reimbursement for lost/damaged property fees (K-12); and the addition of a fee for the cost of a Unified Cheer standard uniform. The Student Fees fund budget is \$250,000 and expenses will be transferred in late August of each fiscal year from the General Fund to “use” all revenue generated by the fund.
