Purpose: Present a snapshot of the 2025-2026 district demographics and statistical profile to the Board of Education.

Background: Overview of district enrollment data and student group counts:

- District K-12 enrollment for the 2025-26 school year is 6,143, which is a slight decrease over last year.
- Hispanics are the largest Ethnic group, representing 13.56% of the total K-12 enrollment. Hispanic enrollment continues to increase.
- English Language Learner enrollment had a slight decrease from 5.03% to 4.86% of total enrollment.
- Fourth grade and sixth grade enrollment numbers remain high.
- Kindergarten and first grade enrollment numbers are lower than in the past years .
- Option enrollment accounts for 32.93 percent of the student population. That figure is a slight decrease of the previous year of 33.13 percent.
- District ethnic breakdown continues to remain relatively the same.
