2025–2026 Key Highlights

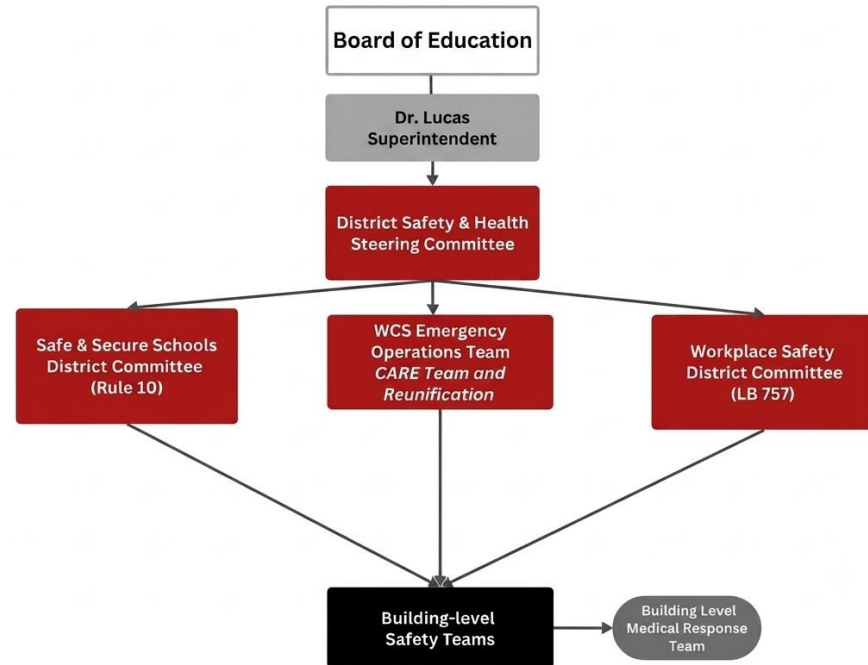
Tech & Infrastructure: OPD Axon Fusus ROC integration, District EOP updates, i66 facility upgrades, and elopement protocols.

People-Powered Safety: Technology enhances our security, but our people protect our community.

Embedded Culture: Rigorous door-propping protocols and district-wide A.L.I.C.E. principles.

New for 2026–27: Introducing badge access audits and unannounced lockdown drills to test real-world readiness.



REUNIFICATION TRAINING

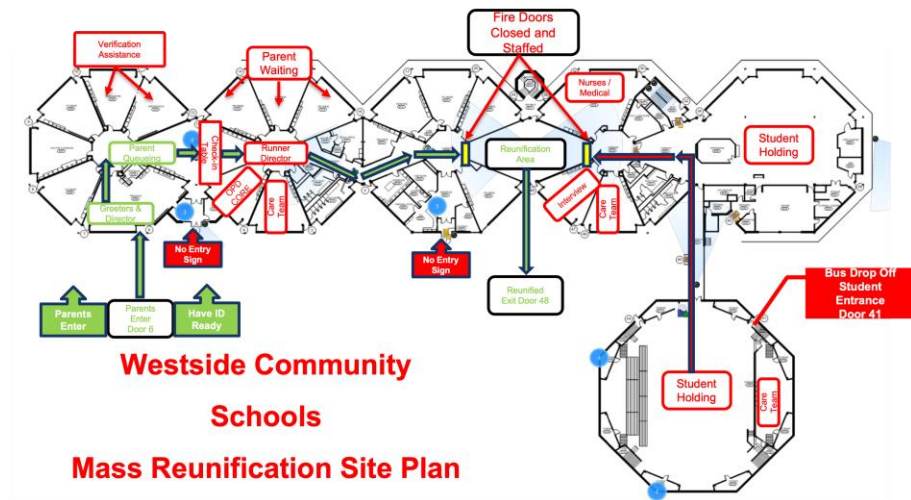
Reunification Team Established:

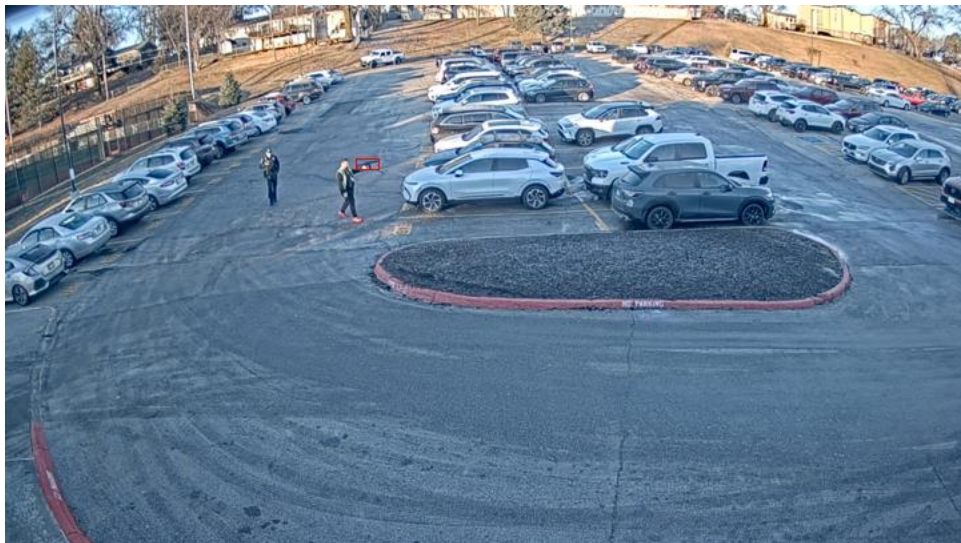
Initial training on July 1, 2026, using Raptor Emergency Management Reunification software.

Site Plan: Safety protocols and site designs fully vetted and approved by the Safety & Health Steering Committee.

Branded Site Signage: Custom site signage created to ensure clear directional routing during an event.

Logistics & Readiness: Finalizing team notification workflows and transportation logistics ahead of future training sessions.





800+ Monitored Cameras: Continuously scanned by ZeroEyes visual gun detection system.

ZeroEyes - Raptor Integration: Lethal threat detections automatically trigger Raptor lockdowns.

Raptor - Genetec Integration: Automatically engages locks, drops fire doors, initiates announcements, and sends emergency panic alarms.

ZeroEyes → Raptor Lockdown → Genetec < 5 sec!

District Wide Testing 9/8/2026

AXON



Exclusive Capability: WCS is the first and only school district integrated with the Omaha Police Real-Time Operation Center (ROC) via Axon Fusus.

Direct ROC Feed: Gives law enforcement immediate camera access and live situational awareness during an emergency.

Zero 911 Delay: Cuts out traditional dispatch wait times for faster emergency response.

Guided Officer Dispatch: ROC operators direct responding units straight to the active threat, saving time and lives.



WHS SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS

Full Door Monitoring: Added position sensors on every door and dedicated alarms on high-violation access points.

Biometric Student Entry: Fingerprint access keeps doors locked full-time during before/after-school activities.

Streamlined Vestibule Control: Enabled Student ID QR code entry through the secure main entrance.

Blind Spot Elimination: Repurposed existing cameras across the facility to fill coverage gaps and eliminate high-risk blind spots.
