Recommendation(s): None at this time. Update to the Board of Education on the schematic design for the WMS Track and Field project.

Background: Alley Poyner Macchietto Architecture (APMA) is contracted by Westside Community Schools to design the Westside Middle School Track and Field Upgrade Project. The project includes: installing a synthetic turf field; a new track with jump pits; 1,000-seat grandstands; a concession/restroom building; field lighting; and a public address system. The north grass area behind the grandstands will be converted into a throwing venue featuring dual-direction discus rings and six shot put pads.

APMA will present the Design Development plans for Board approval at the September 21, 2026, Board of Education meeting.

Project design is anticipated to be completed in November 2026, with bidding in December 2026. Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2027, with the field and track substantially completed before the start of the 2027-28 school year. The track surface is expected to be finished in August 2027, and the concession/restroom building in December 2027.
