All public school districts in Nebraska that provide elementary and/or secondary instruction to children of compulsory attendance age are required to be accredited under standards prescribed by the State Board of Education. That systematic ongoing process guides planning, implementation, evaluation and renewal of the school design model to meet local and statewide goals and priorities. The focus is on improving student learning, which includes procedures and strategies to address quality learning, equity, and accountability.

The Board ~~of Education~~ delegates to the Superintendent or designee the responsibility of maintaining an instructional program that meets approved accreditation standards.
