# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Night at FLHS

Wednesday, February 5 (snow date: February 6) 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m., at FLHS (see locations below) The evening will include presentations on high school curriculum, information on selecting courses, an overview of the 8<sup>th</sup>-to-9<sup>th</sup>-grade transition process, <u>the new high school graduation requirements</u>, and a tour of classrooms related to our elective areas. The evening will be divided into two parts:

Families with last names A—M should report to the auditorium, while families with last names N—Z should report to the Library Media Center. At 8:00 p.m. we will switch the two groups.
