

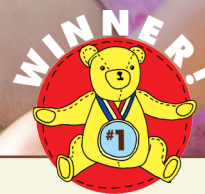

BOW CRAFT OVERNIGHT CAMP

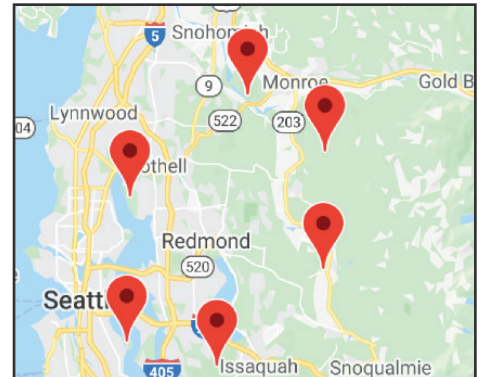
