The CFISD Presenter Institute (CPI) affords leaders with a unique experience that is tailored to assist them in acquiring and refining skillsets required when designing and facilitating learning for adults. The aim of the institute is to provide leaders with a balance of theory and practice by offering purposeful tools for connecting audiences to the leader, to each other, and to important content.

## Benefits

Participants will engage in relevant learning opportunities resulting in increased understanding of what is involved in the design and delivery of learning for adults. Participants walk away with both a better understanding of who they are as leaders and the confidence to lead learning effectively.

## Program Design

Fueled with the knowledge that leaders are often responsible for designing and delivering high-quality professional learning for adults, the district's professional learning team first envisioned, then developed CPI. The content of CPI is designed in a purposeful spiral of topics allowing participants to expand their repertoire of skills, strategies, and techniques.

## Expectations

CPI is a year-long institute and attendance at each of the six (6) planned meetings is essential. Each meeting builds upon the next.

Leaders at all levels may select to join CPI. The primary audience usually comprises leaders at the district level, including coaches, coordinators, assistant directors, directors, managers, and assistant superintendents, among others.
