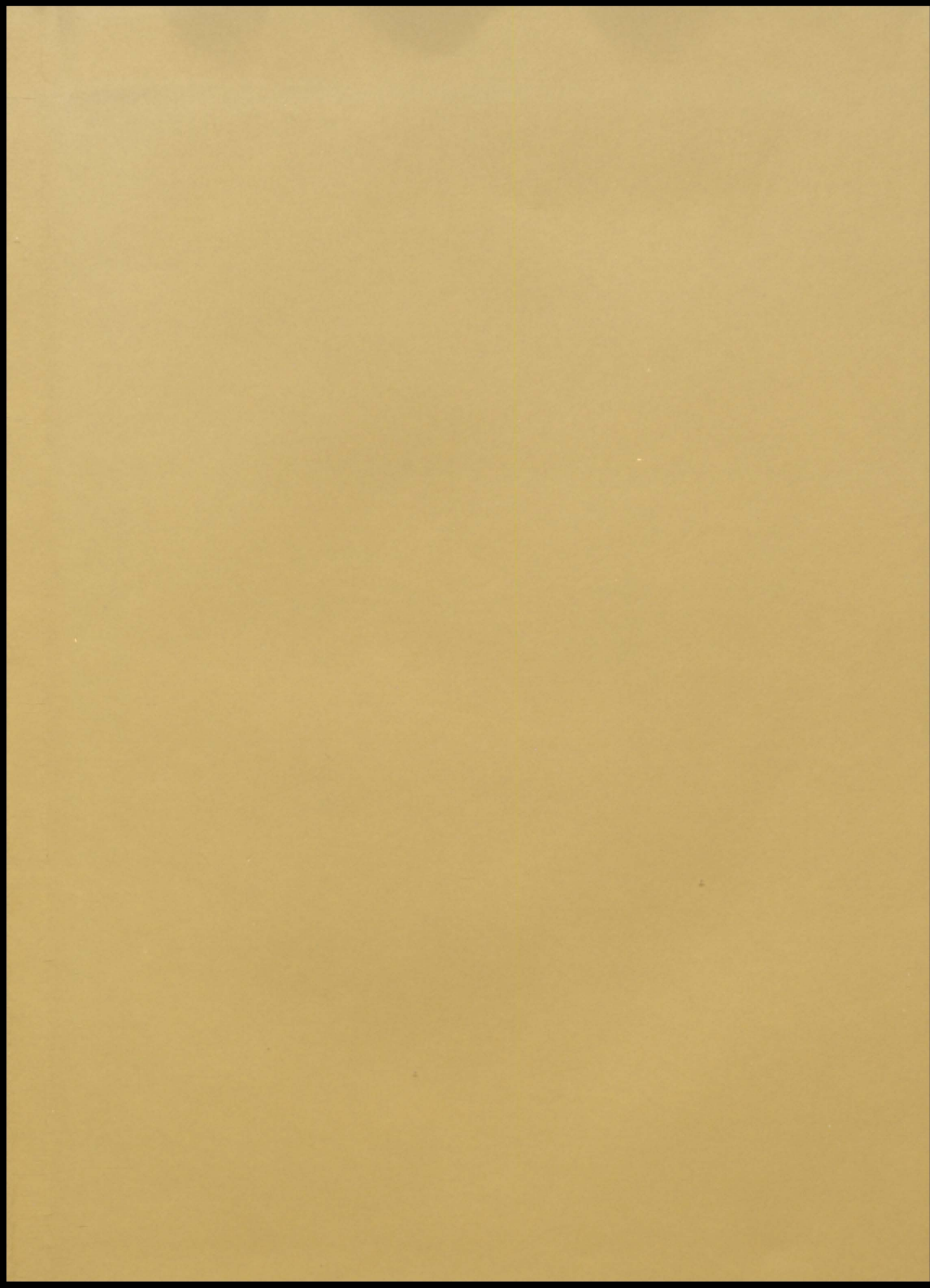


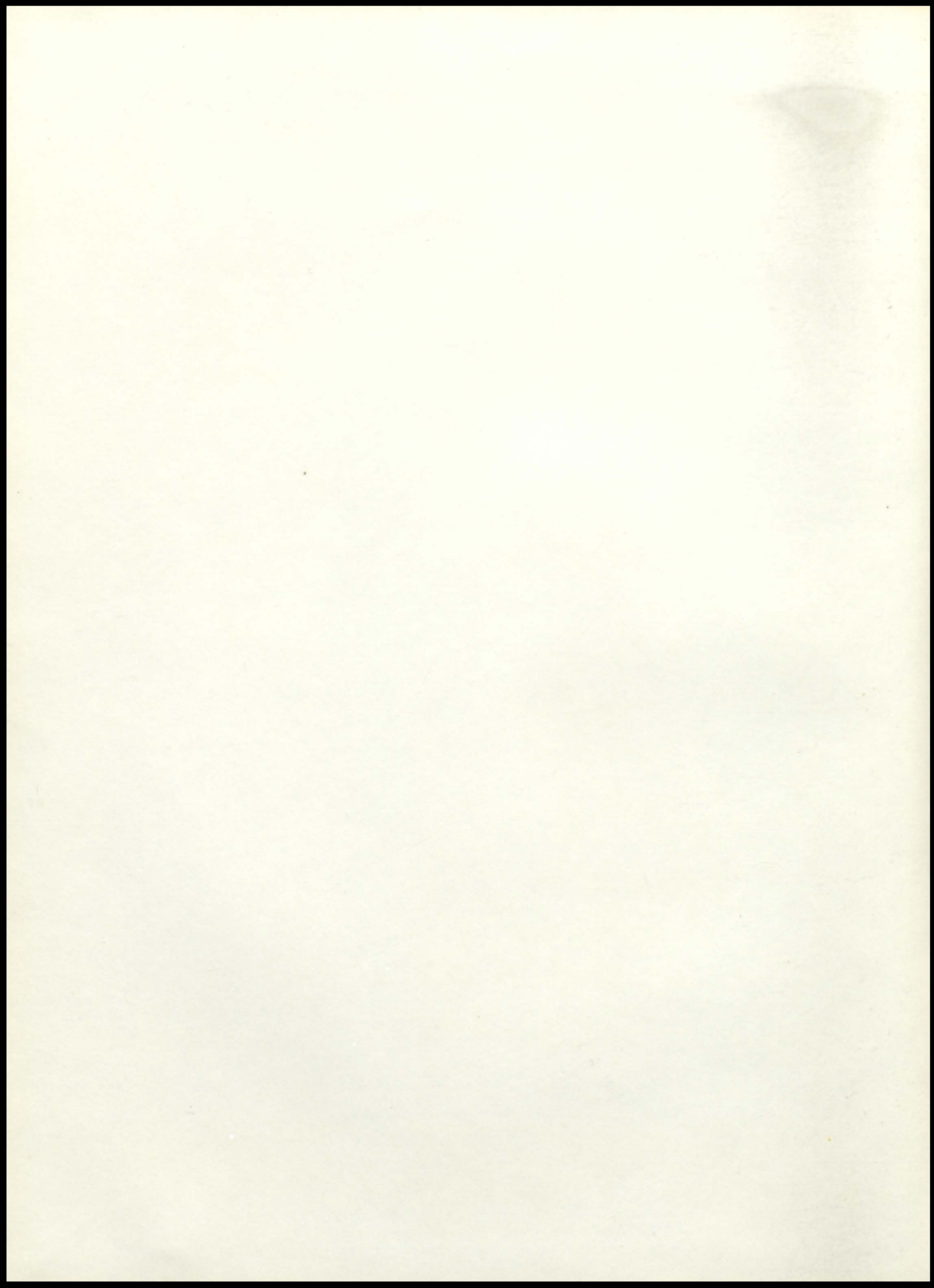

Upper Right are a few seniors who had to get into the act. They are, Susan Halter, Gayle Johnson, Joe Skroch, and Lynnette Fargen.

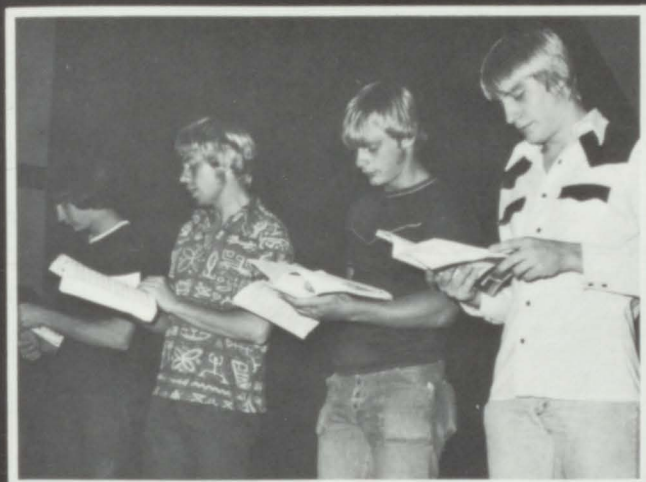

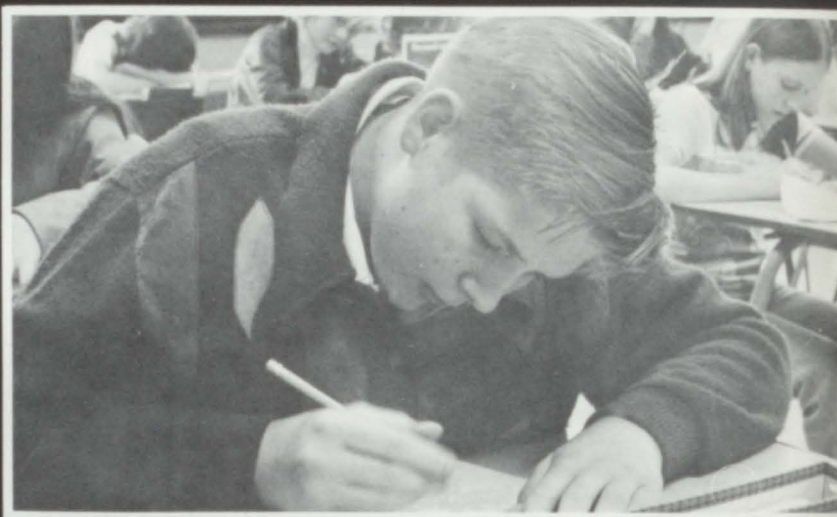

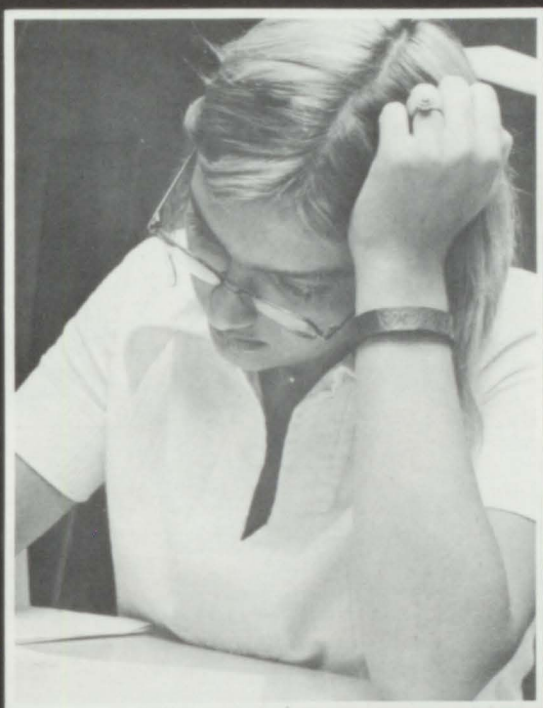

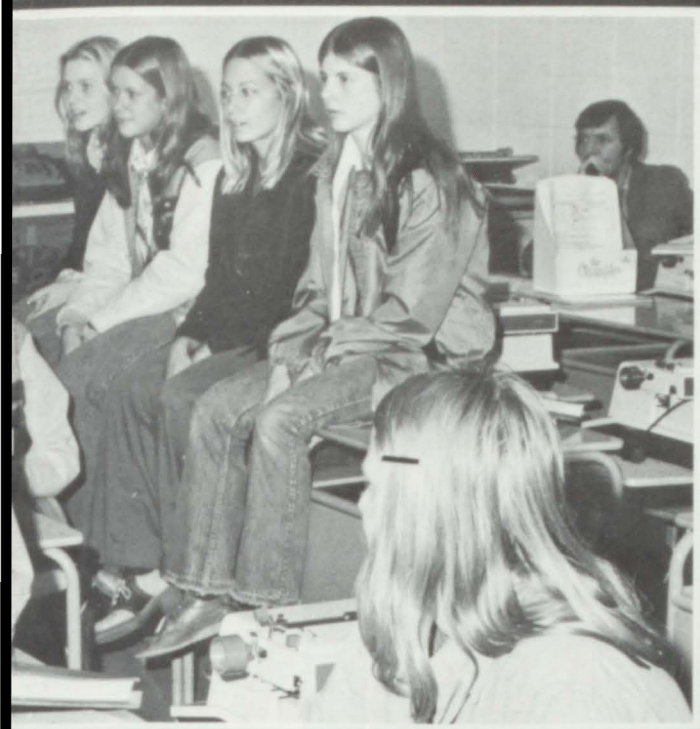

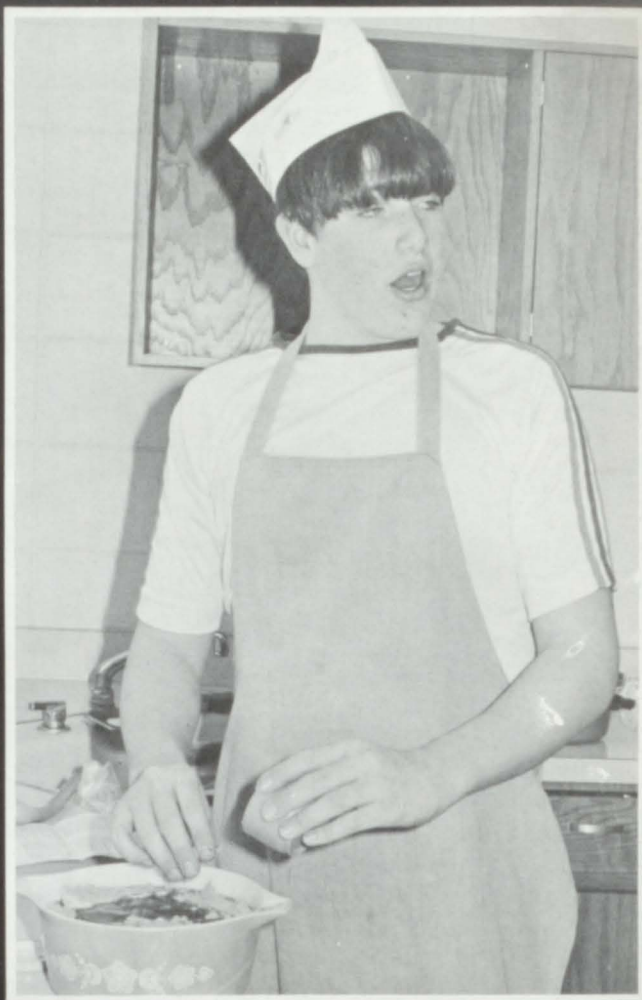

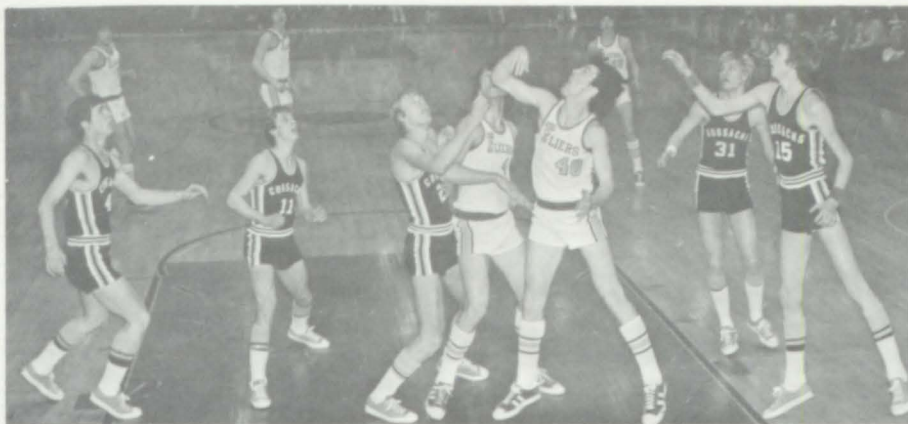

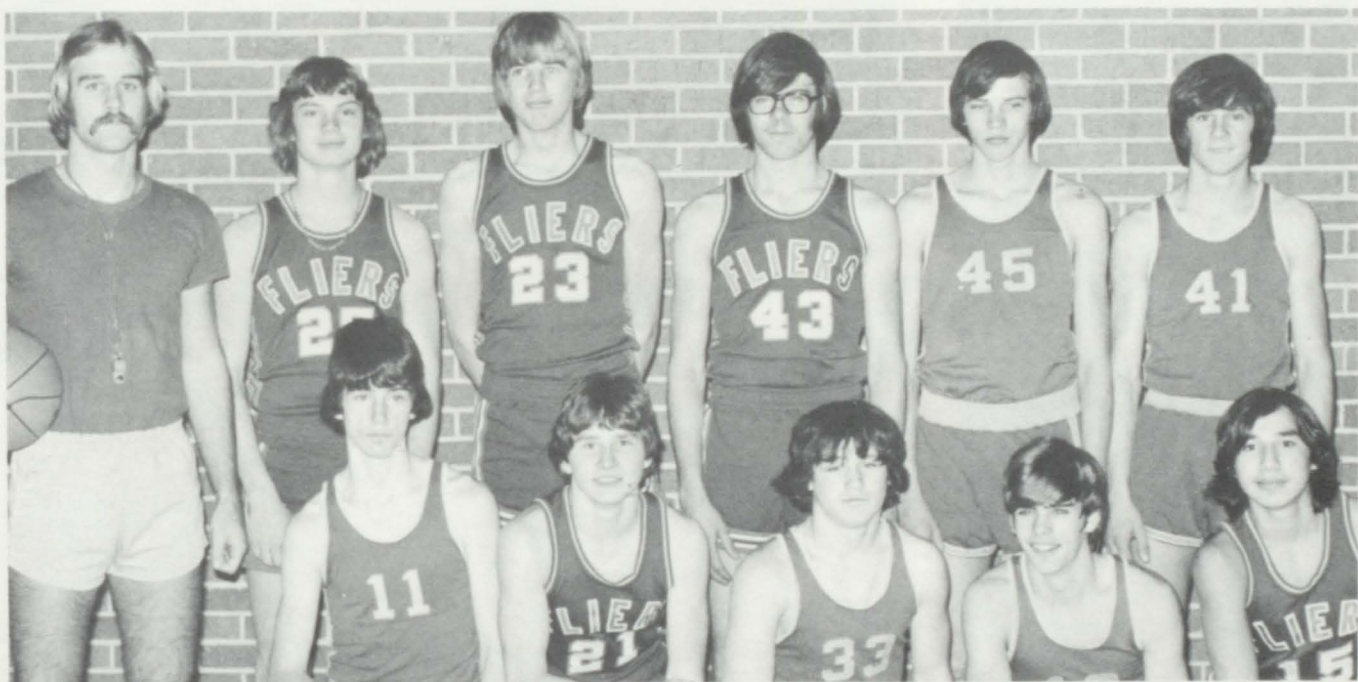

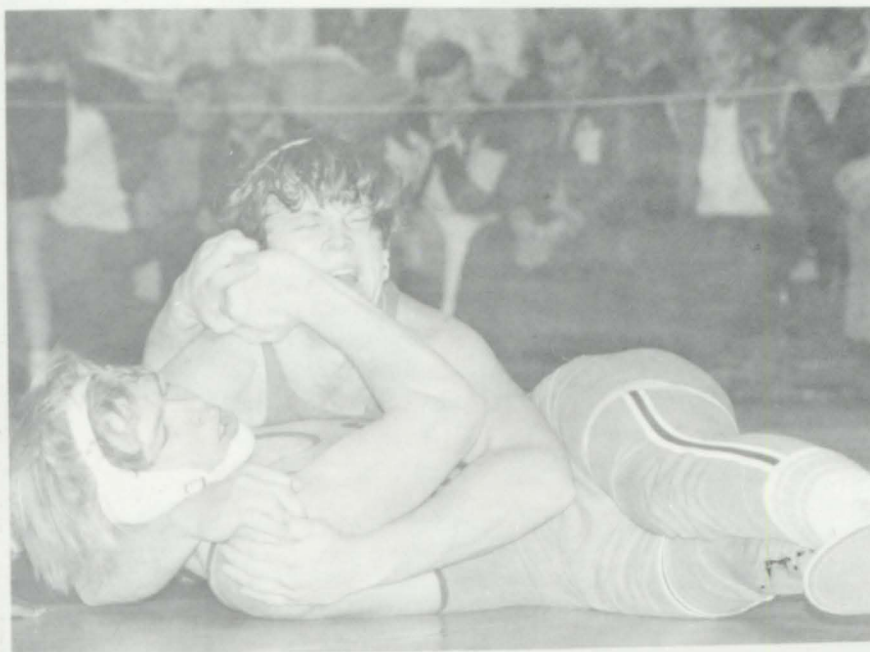

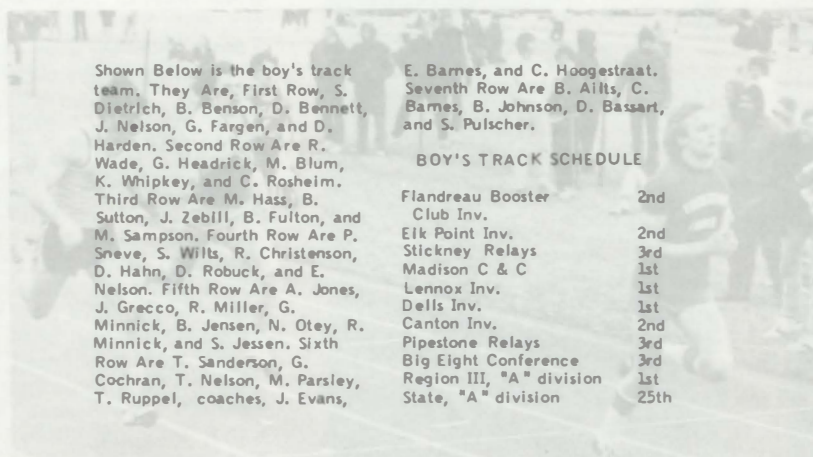

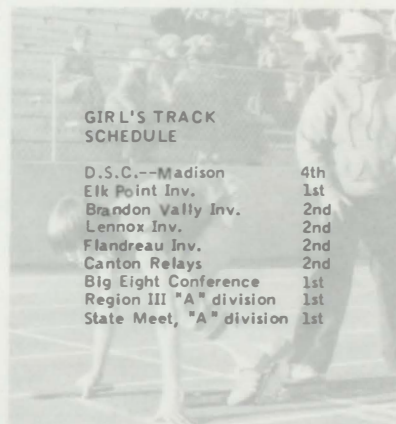

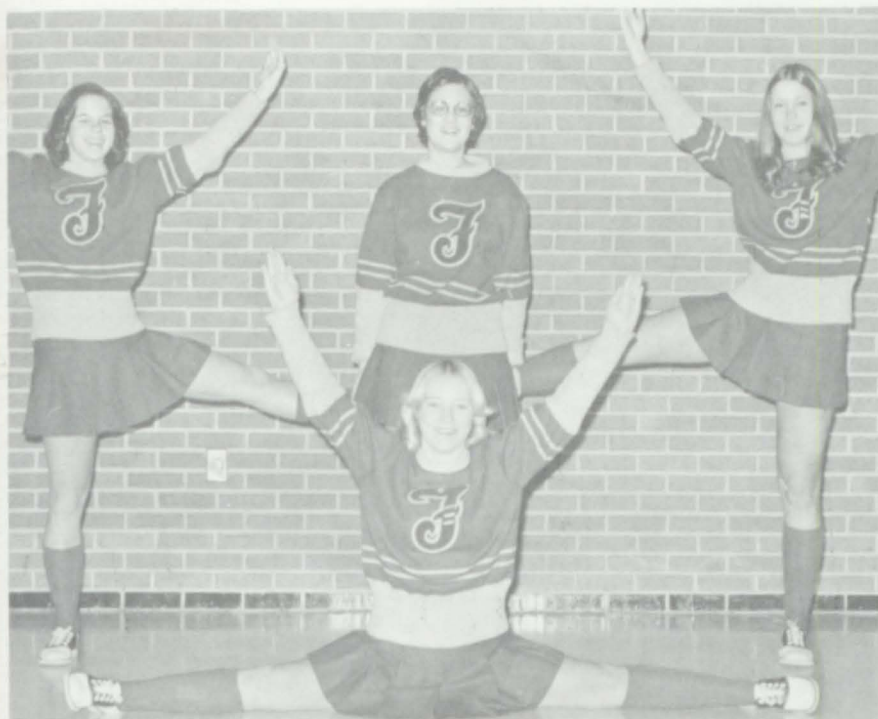

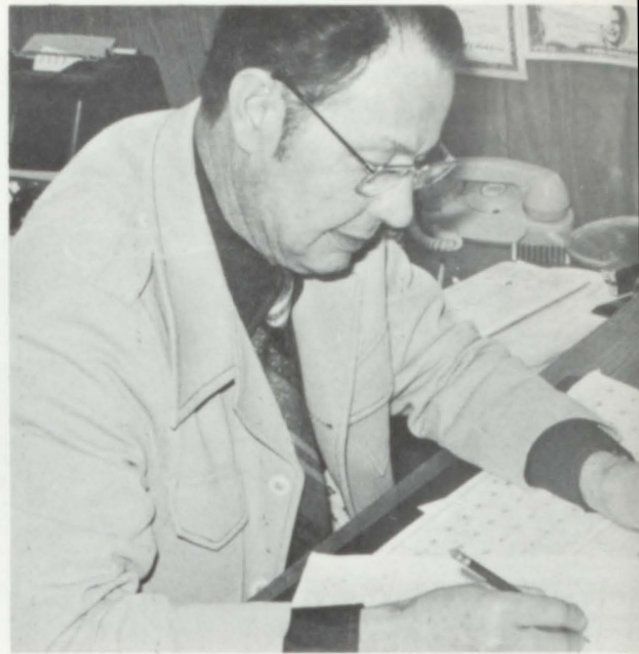

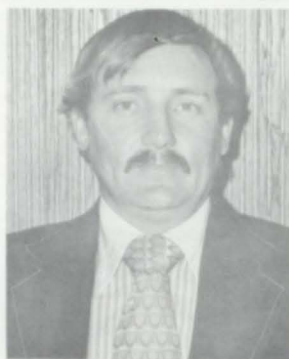

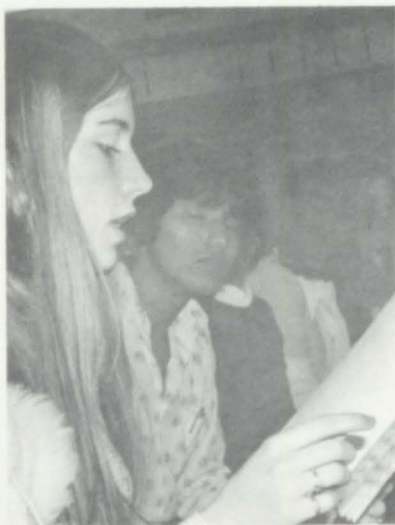

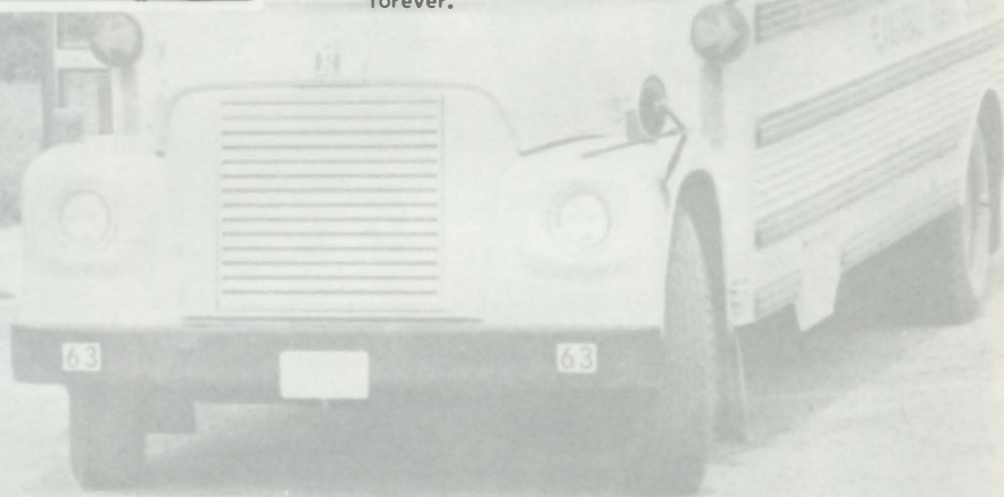


In Memorial to Tammy Grafing
