

## Warren County Schools: Consent for Audio Recording in ESL Program

Effective July 1, 2024, the Families' Rights and Responsibilities Act requires parents/guardians to grant or withhold consent for Warren County Schools to audio record students as part of the English as a Second Language (ESL) program.

**Note:** This consent form pertains specifically to audio recording during English Language Proficiency assessments, including the Alternate English Language Proficiency Assessment (Alt ELPA) and the English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA). These assessments are essential for evaluating and supporting your child's language development. Pursuant to the Families' Rights and Responsibilities Act and Tenn. Code Ann. § 63-1-173(c)(1), I am the parent/guardian of:
