Public Hearing Regarding Closing of Schools and Student Reassignment <a href="#">Appendix 1</a>	<p>On January 22, 2024, at the Board's regular meeting, the Board received information projecting a \$42 million shortfall for the 2024-25 fiscal year. At the recommendation of administration, the Board requested staff identify potential building closures to eliminate this shortfall.</p> <p>At the Board's request, on February 12, 2024, at the Board's regular meeting, administration proposed closing the following buildings: Hadley Middle School, Jardine STEM Career Exploration Magnet School, Clark Elementary School, Cleaveland Traditional Magnet School, Park Elementary School, and Payne Elementary School.</p> <p>At that same meeting, the Board announced a public hearing to be held on February 29, 2024, regarding the proposed school closures. The Board also authorized publication of a notice of hearing. This notice is found in Appendix 1 and was published in the Wichita Eagle on February 14 and February 18, 2024.</p>
	<p>Before starting the public hearing, Board President Stan Reeser thanked all those in attendance for participating and reminded them the purpose of the hearing was for the Board to listen and gather feedback from interested members of the public. Mr. Reeser said the Board would consider everyone's opinion and take final action at the next regular BOE meeting on Monday, March 4, 2024.</p>
