Student athlete chooses to quit a sport before that season ends.

An open line of communication is critical to ensure everyone is on the same page. When an issue develops between the student-athlete and their coach, it may be talked out after practice. However, there are times when a meeting is necessary, involving all stakeholders. This meeting will always include the coach and the student-athlete, the two common denominators in the case. The student-athlete's voice is not just important, it's crucial in these discussions. Their perspective is integral, and all parties need to hear from them what happened.

Whenever a situation develops, and the parents want to meet with their student-athletes coach, the following are expected to be in attendance; the meeting will not occur until they all are present.

- 1) Head Coach of the sport
- 2) Assistant Coach of the sport
- 3) Student-athlete
- 4) Parent(s) of the student-athlete

If a student or parent chooses to quit the sport that they are currently in and is in season, it's important to note that they will not be allowed to move to their next sport until the sport that they quit completes their UIL season.
