POSITION SUMMARY:

Oregon Community Education & Recreation is looking for responsible, hard-working, and friendly individuals to join our team in the role of Summer Playground Leader! Summer Playground Leaders are responsible for the safety and supervision of youth participants, ages 6-11, while leading both structured and semi-structured activities including, but not limited to, sports, arts & crafts, games, field trips, and weekly trips to the Oregon Pool.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Be a positive role model to the youth participants in your attitude and behavior, cleanliness, punctuality, responsibility, and sportsmanship
- Create a safe environment and space in which youth participants feel comfortable
- Lead and/or co-lead youth participants through daily activities and themed weeks
- Be actively engaged with youth participants during program hours
- Be a responsible and reliable chaperone to youth participants on weekly off-site field trips and weekly trips to the Oregon Pool
- Enforce Summer Playground program rules
- Ensure Summer Playground sites are kept cleaned, organized, and maintained
- Maintain a consistent and reliable attendance record; provide a minimum of two (2) weeks' notice for any planned absences
- Must have the ability to follow and enforce all safety rules, regulations, and procedures as required by the Oregon School District and Oregon Community Education & Recreation
- Performs related duties as assigned

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be an incoming high school sophomore or older
- Must possess or have the ability to obtain American Red Cross Training Certification in First Aid and CPR (training will be provided at no cost to employees)
- Must be willing to work outside in warm, hot, and/or rainy weather at times
- Must be willing to actively supervise children while in the water

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Prior experience working with children
- Ability to lead children, ages 6-11, in an engaging and fun manner
- Possesses the patience, desire, and ability to work with children in both indoor and outdoor environments, as well as in the water
- Basic knowledge of different sports, arts & crafts, and/or various activities
- Possesses strong communication skills
- Must have access to reliable transportation to get to work

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Frequently walking, running, standing, sitting, talking, and hearing

- Ability to perform tasks on potentially rough or uneven surfaces
