

EXECUTIVE FUNCTION OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY VS. TUTORING SERVICES

Executive Function Occupational Therapy	Tutoring Services
 Work with student to identify strengths and weakness <u>related to EF skills</u> 	 Work with student to identify strengths and weakness related to a specific class or content area
Educate students on how to <u>ACCESS</u> the curriculum	Educate students <u>ON</u> the curriculum
 Teach strategies that can be generalized and applied across classes EF OT teaches test-taking tips, direction-following techniques, organization, self-advocacy, time management, study skills, attention strategies, ETC support for student can be applied to all subjects 	 Teach content specific strategies for one area of need math tutor teaches how to do math/strategies for math support student with 1 subject
EF demands lead the session (ie: how can we address a specific skill?)	HW demands lead the session (ie: what assignment is due for the class)
 Needs are identified through use of standardized approach (ie: BRIEF) 	 Needs are identified through <u>non-</u> <u>standardized</u> approach (ie: student performance and/or parent/teacher concern)
 EF OT teaches strategies to develop and improve skills as a <u>long term</u> solution 	Tutoring is often most effective as a <u>short</u> <u>term</u> solution
