How are Duchossois Scholars Selected?

- Semi-Finalists are selected from all candidates who have completed the Culver Academies Application Process **and** have submitted a Merit Scholarship Application by **January 15**.
- Finalists are selected by the Duchossois Scholarship Selection Committee, comprised of Culver faculty and staff.
- Finalists and a parent are invited to campus for a Duchossois Scholarship Weekend; which includes an interview with the Duchossois Scholarship Selection Committee and a celebration banquet dinner.
- Scholars are notified by the Duchossois Scholarship Committee.
