Reading: Fiction, Drama, & Poetry

Reading: Informational Text

- <u>Key Ideas & Details</u>: Use key ideas and details in non-fiction texts to support analysis, inferences, central ideas, and summaries.
- <u>Craft & Structure</u>: Determine diction, structure, and purpose, and analyze their contributions to informational text.
- <u>Integration of Knowledge & Ideas</u>: Evaluate the claims in a text, or compare and contrast the text to the same topic presented in multimedia versions or by different authors.
- Range of Reading & Level of Text Complexity: Read and comprehend nonfiction.

Writing

- Argument: Write arguments to support claims.
- <u>Informative/Explanatory</u>: Write informative/explanatory texts to examine a topic and convey ideas, concepts, and information.
- Narrative: Write stories to develop real or imagined experiences or events.
- <u>Production and Distribution of Writing</u>: Develop, strengthen, produce, and publish coherent, purposeful writing.
- Research to Build & Present Knowledge: Conduct short research projects.
- Range of Writing: Write routinely over extended and shorter time frames.

Speaking & Listening

- <u>Collaboration</u>: Engage in group discussions, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly.
- <u>Comprehension</u>: Analyze presentations in diverse formats.
- <u>Presentation of Knowledge & Ideas</u>: Present claims and findings in a coherent, appropriate manner, using multimedia components.
