Reading: Fiction, Drama, & Poetry

- <u>Key Ideas & Details</u>: Use textual evidence to support analysis, inferences, themes, and summaries, and to analyze the impacts of the author's choices.

Reading: Informational Text

- <u>Key Ideas & Details</u>: Analyze textual evidence in non-fiction texts to support analysis, inferences, central ideas, relationships, summaries, and development.
- <u>Craft & Structure</u>: Analyze how the author advances purpose, power, persuasiveness, or beauty through diction, structure, and point of view.
- <u>Integration of Knowledge & Ideas</u>: Integrate, evaluate, and analyze multiple sources of information for themes, purposes, and features.
- Range of Reading & Level of Text Complexity: Read and comprehend nonfiction, including influential global texts.

Writing

- <u>Argument</u>: Write arguments to support claims, using valid reasoning and relevant and sufficient evidence.
- <u>Informative/Explanatory</u>: Write informative/explanatory texts to examine a topic and convey complex ideas, concepts, and information.
- Narrative: Write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences or events.
- <u>Production and Distribution of Writing</u>: Develop, strengthen, produce, publish, and update coherent, purposeful writing.
- Research to Build & Present Knowledge: Conduct short, as well as more substantial, research projects, drawing on evidence to support analysis and reflection.
- Range of Writing: Write routinely over extended and shorter time frames.

Speaking & Listening

- <u>Collaboration</u>: Initiate and participate in a range of collaborative discussions, building on others' ideas and expressing their own.
- <u>Comprehension</u>: Integrate and evaluate multiple sources of information presented in diverse formats.
