Description of Curriculum:

Second grade students were exposed to the following skills and strategies during the first quarter: long a, i, e, o, and u, r-controlled vowels, consonant digraphs, silent letters, endings –s and -es, contractions, syllable patterns, plural nouns, double consonants, and homophones, determine author's purpose, determine important information, recall and retell, make inferences, identify details and facts, make predictions, and summarize. Vocabulary skills and strategies taught during this marking period include: use context clues, dictionary usage, and identify descriptive language. In writing and grammar, students were exposed to the following: personal narrative, story, report, sentences, statements and questions, exclamations and imperatives, subjects and predicates, singular and plural common nouns, plural nouns with spelling changes, proper nouns, and nouns that show ownership.
