RESOLUTION NO. 22-17 Levy Recertification

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Highline School District No. 401, King County, Washington, recertifying to the Superintendent of Puget Sound Educational Service District and the Metropolitan King County Council, the total amount of (1) the General Fund excess property tax levy to be levied in year 2017 and collected in year 2018.

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Highline School District No. 401, King County Washington (the "District") hereby makes the following findings and determinations:

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2015, the voters within the District approved a three-year General Fund educational programs and operation excess property tax levy, with the third year excess property taxes to be levied in 2017 for collection in 2018 of an amount not to exceed \$64,681,000.

WHEREAS, the Board, by Resolution No. 14-17, adopted a budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18 that certified General Fund educational programs and operation excess property taxes in the amount of \$61,228,888 to be levied in 2017 and collected in 2018.

WHEREAS, as a result of new information received from the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Board has determined that the amount of the District's General Fund educational programs and operation excess property tax levy previously certified in the District's budget for Fiscal Year 2017-18 of \$61,228,888 should now be <u>increased</u> to \$62,461,665.

NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Highline School District No. 401, King County, Washington, pursuant to RCW 82.54.020, the Board hereby recertifies to the Superintendent of Puget Sound Education Service District and the Metropolitan King County Council, an excess property tax levy in the amount of \$62,461,665 for the District's General Fund, which amount shall be levied in calendar year 2017 and collected in calendar year 2018. The final tax levy may be adjusted for Administrative Refunds of prior year levies as identified by King County.
