A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties, Washington, to participate in a Joint Purchasing Agreement with ~~E&I Cooperative Services~~ for the purchase of automotive equipment, furniture and various supplies;

WHEREAS, the State has authorized interlocal cooperation agreements between other governmental agencies or agents; and

WHEREAS E&I Cooperative Services has awarded a contract to multiple vendors for the purchase of automotive equipment, furniture and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the contract allows for the extension of the terms and conditions of the contract to Northshore School District and other school districts to the extent permitted by law; and


WHEREAS, Northshore School District wishes to reduce the cost of purchasing automotive equipment, furniture and supplies needed to support the operation of the school district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties Washington, and E&I Cooperative Services, hereby agree as follows:


1. That an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement be formed between Northshore School District No. 417 and E&I Cooperative Services for the purpose of purchasing automotive equipment, furniture and various supplies.
2. That the superintendent or designee of Northshore School District No. 417 is hereby authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.
3. Northshore School District No. 417 reserves the right to contract independently for the purpose of any items or services, with or without notice to E&I Cooperative Services.




