RESOLUTION NO 706

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties, Washington, to participate in a Joint Purchasing Agreement with Educational Service District 112 (ESD 112), Clark County Washington, for purchase of furniture, supplies and equipment;

WHEREAS, the State has authorized interlocal cooperation agreements between other governmental agencies or agents; and

WHEREAS, ESD 112 has awarded a contracts to various vendors for the purchase of furniture, supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the contract allows for the extension of the terms and conditions of the contract to the Northshore School District and other school districts to the extent permitted by law; and


WHEREAS, the Northshore School District wishes to reduce the cost of purchasing furniture, supplies and equipment needed to support the operation of the school district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Northshore School District No. 417, King and Snohomish Counties Washington, and ESD 112, Clark County, Washington hereby agrees as follows:

1. That an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement be formed between the Northshore School District No. 417 and Education Service District 112 for the purpose of purchasing furniture, supplies, and equipment.
2. That the superintendent or designee of the Northshore School District No. 417 is hereby authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.
3. The Northshore School District No. 417 reserves the right to contract independently for the purpose of any items or services, with or without notice to ESD 112.




