INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT/CONTRACT TO PERFORM GOVERNMENTAL ACTIVITIES FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED STUDENTS 2008-2009

I. Identification of Parties

Snohomish School District No. 201, Snohomish, Washington, and Northshore School District No. 417, Bothell, Washington, do each agree to enter into a contract wherein the Snohomish School district and Northshore School Districts jointly share the equivalent of a 1.0 FTE certificated vision specialist according to the terms and conditions described herein.

II. Authorization of Contract

RCW 39.34.080 and RCW 28A.320 provides that any one or more public agencies may contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking, which each public agency entering into the contract is authorized by law to perform.

III. Purpose and Objectives of the Agreement/Contract

The Snohomish and Northshore School Districts each require the services of certificated staff members to provide instruction to visually impaired students. The Snohomish School District will hire 1.0 FTE certificated vision specialist and Northshore School District will use services of the instructor at the rate of .40 FTE certificated instructor for the 2008 – 2009 school year.

IV. Powers, Rights and Responsibilities of the Snohomish School District

A. The Snohomish School District will employ 1.0 FTE certificated staff specially trained to work with the visually impaired. This shall include, in addition to salary costs, the payment of all payroll taxes and liability for all employee statutory benefits, health benefits, and all other monetary entitlements of the Snohomish School District's SEA collective bargaining agreement.

B. The Snohomish School District will invoice the Northshore School District for .4 of the actual certificated costs for the 2008 – 2009 school year. Northshore School District will be responsible for providing classroom/student supplies, text books and other related costs.



- C. The Snohomish School District shall be responsible for all state and federal reporting on taxes and retirement pertaining to this position.
- D. The Snohomish School District Executive Director of Special Services will work with the Northshore School District Director of Special Services to establish the service calendar to ensure that each district receives its appropriate services of the certificated employee to work with visually impaired students.

V. Powers, Rights and Responsibilities of Northshore School District

- A. Northshore School District retains the power and right to monitor and direct the activities of the certificated employees during service by the employees of Northshore School District.
- B. Northshore School District will pay to the Snohomish School District .4 FTE of the actual costs associated with the employment of the vision specialist. Payment will be made within thirty (30) days of invoicing by the Snohomish School District.
- C. Northshore School District will remain responsible for forty percent of the costs associated with the employment of the vision employees for the period of the 2008 2009 school year even if it no longer requires the employee's services to support visually impaired students.

VI. Read and Understood, Entirety of Agreement

By signing below, the Superintendents of Snohomish School District and Northshore School District acknowledge that their Boards of Directors, respectively, have approved this agreement, have read and understood this agreement in its entirety and agree that this written agreement is the entire agreement and agree to all terms herein.
