PSP – WHAT IS IT?

The Professional Standards Program (PSP) is a voluntary program established by the National Association of Educational Office Professionals (NAEOP) as an incentive for professional growth. Those who participate must meet specific criteria established by the Professional Standards Program Institute. Acceptance into the program is based on achievement in the areas of education, experience, and professional activities and carries with it a certificate of recognition and a monthly stipend.
