It is a class B misdemeanor for the parent of [a] schoolage child to intentionally or recklessly fail to meet with the designated school authorities to discuss the school-age child's school attendance problems; or fail to prevent the school-age child from being absent without a valid excuse five or more times during the remainder of the school year." (See U.C.A 53G-6-202).
