Essential skills and knowledge for this Davis School District Program

Counselors will guide students through the implementation of a Student Education and Occupation Plan (SEOP).

Support personal/social development.

- a. Increase self-knowledge by identifying individual interests, aptitudes, abilities, and personal goals.
- b. Improve positive self-concept through encouragement of student achievement.
- c. Develop relationship/social skills through guidance activities and group or individual counseling.
- d. Provide emotional support to students dealing with personal issues.

Encourage academic success through advisement and advocacy.

- a. Develop next-step planning options consistent with interests, achievement, aptitudes, and abilities.
- b. Plan with students and parents to provide a challenging schedule of classes.
- c. Track student credit toward graduation.
- d. Match students with appropriate credit remediation and academic interventions.

Guide education and career planning and preparation.

- a. Explore post-high school alternatives.
- b. Encourage rigorous coursework for college preparation.
- c. Research college options and scholarship opportunities.
- d. Explore career pathways related to personal interests.
- e. Develop a plan to reach future career goals.

Promote civic responsibility.

- a. Participation in school and community activities.
- b. Gain an awareness of the needs of others through service.
