1. **Welcome (Brian Bolinder)**
2. **Approval of Minutes from November 16, 2016** – Motion to approve by Jenny Pitt, 2nd Lisa Robinson, Motion passed unanimously.
3. **Counselor Report (Gordon Griffiths)** – Counseling center is working through class changes. CCR's for 7th grade are being completed and the Counselors are pleased with the process. Discussion regarding the addition of a fitness class as an elective (in addition to current PE offering).
4. **Teacher Report (Shelly Damron, JSSC Chair)** – Teachers are reviewing class offerings for 2017-18 and are making recommendations. This includes changes in the electives being offered for certain grades. Discussion regarding addition of Computer Tech course in 8th Grade as a required 0.5 credit course. This requirement may have an adverse effect on those students interested in the fine arts, including band. CJH recently hired Mr. Frohm to replace Mr. Siegel as band instructor. Discussion regarding impact on faculty and rooms. Any concerns need to be voiced to Laura Belnap, our State School Board Representative.
5. **Student Report (Ally Seelos)** – Student Council is preparing for Spirit Week January 23-27. Events include Pajama Day, Twin Day, Hat Day, Black Out during Chargerette game, and Fanny Pack Friday.
6. **2015-2016 Trust Lands Expenditure Update (Spencer Hansen)** – (See Actual Trustland Budget Handout) Actual Expenditures as of January 10, 2017. Expenditures appear on track and no questions were presented.
7. **Report:**
 - a. **2017-18 Preliminary Trust Land Budget Review (Spencer Hansen)** – (See Preliminary Trustland Budget Handout) Conservative budget estimate of \$68,000.00 for 2017-18. Distribution of ~34% to Salaries/Support; ~54% Technology/Software; and ~12% to Teacher Development. No questions
 - b. **2017-18 Rough Draft SIP Goals Review (Spencer Hansen)** – (See Draft SIP Goals Handout) Handout identified potential goals following December 14th meeting. December meeting was very productive and identified many potential goals. Handout identifies teacher preferred goals. Some discussion regarding evaluation of draft Goals for CC review and decision in subsequent meeting. CC invited to propose alternative goals. Some discussion occurred regarding use of block schedule with the resulting increase in class sizes. Discussion regarding homework lab rotation to have Social Studies or English teacher rotate through, or be compensated at duty rate.

 - d. **Parent/Community Concerns** – Concerns were discussed during Teacher Report related to additional state requirements and impact on current classes and students.
